Meeting Minutes of February 9, 2005

The Director of Naval Intelligence, Rear Admiral Richard Porterfield, USN, chaired this meeting. The list of attendees is attached (Attachment 1). These minutes reference slides from the briefing to the IJCSG Principals dated February 9, 2005. The briefing is classified and is held at the TIC. [REDACTED]

RADM Porterfield opened the thirty-second meeting of the IJCSG and asked Ms. Dunie to proceed with the briefing. Ms. Dunie began by explaining the next steps in the ISG Candidate Recommendation (CR) process. First, the four CR Justification Packages will be sent for Office of the General Council legal review. Then, the four packages will be forwarded simultaneously to the ISG/IEC. However, prior to forwarding the CRs to the ISG/IEC, DUSD(I) would be briefed. Finally, due to security and classification considerations the IJCSG CRs could go directly to the IEC; this is still undecided. She also stated, "there are some outstanding issues associated with NRO INT - 0011 being worked by the Core Team."

The Principals next discussed Headquarters and Support Activities (H&SA) JCSG CR HSA - 0058, SOUTHCOM Relocation. There was considerable discussion and confusion over the personnel numbers associated with the JIC and JIOC. [REDACTED] reported the H&SA JCSG approved the CR without including the JIOC numbers and the recommendation would be reviewed by the ISG on 25 February. Ms. Dunie asked the J2 representatives to clarify with SOUTHCOM/J2 the exact personnel numbers included in the COBRA by H&SA. Upon conclusion of this discussion, the Principals agreed not to pursue the JIOC concept through the BRAC process.

Next, the group discussed the H&SA CRs that consolidate and collocate Counterintelligence Field Activity/Defense Security Service and adjudication activities at various receiving locations in the NCR. There was considerable confusion as to H&SA intentions with respect to these activities and headquarters components. [REDACTED] suggested to wait until the CRs are posted on the ISG Tracking Tool before taking any action regarding potential receiving locations. Mr. Ewing suggested in the meantime, Ms. Haave host a meeting to get a community position on the matter. The Principals supported this position, and Ms. Dunie and Ms. Haave agreed to take it for action.

Following the CIFA/DSS discussions, [REDACTED], Core Team, presented the summary of data analysis of military value and capacity requested by the Department of the Navy at the last IJCSG meeting. The Principals agreed with the conclusion of the analysis that there are no further scenarios for IJCSG deliberation.

After [REDACTED] presentation, Ms Dunie discussed the results of the Core Team's analysis of leased space, leased space within an existing contractor facility and vulnerable leased space. The Principals reviewed the presentation without comment.

Ms. Dunie and [REDACTED] then described the Red Team process to review the IJCSGs and MilDeps CRs. Ms Dunie mentioned the Core Team had the Mr. Wynne's memo which outlined the Red Team process. There was some discussion on the team's composition.
