

- **Capacity Analysis Results:** The initial Capacity Analysis for MAH was conducted by gathering data across CONUS. These results are summarized on the tables below. The Capacity Analysis Report includes data which compare the total space currently on an installation or occupied by the Activity against what is required at an average space requirement of 200 GSF per person, used as a means to estimate the shortfall or excess of space which may currently exist, after accounting for surge requirements.

The scope of work undertaken by the HSA JCSG was generally limited to headquarters and administration facilities located within 100 miles of the Pentagon, unless otherwise specifically defined. The OSD, Defense Agencies, Field Activities and related locations analyzed are shown on Table 3, found on the second-to-last table of this section. Table 3 was used to identify facilities for specific review and to accumulate capacity and other data for use in subsequent analysis tasks.

The locations of the administrative spaces occupied by that were considered in the analysis for OSD, WHS, DTSA, DoDEA, DoD IG, DCMA and DHRA are summarized in Table 3 on following pages. Table 4 (Summary Movement Model), which is included on the last page, shows the specific current leased locations of the activities to be moved under this candidate recommendation.
