## MEMORANDUM FOR DIRECTOR, BASE REALIGNMENT AND CLOSURE

Subj: COORDINATION OF BRAC 2005 CAPACITY ANALYSIS QUESTIONS

The Department of Navy (DON) has reviewed the content of the Capacity Data call as requested in your memo of December 15, 2003 and has determined it is adequate for release to DON activities. Our Infrastructure Analysis Team, in conjunction with other Service/Joint Cross Service Group representatives, is compiling suggested minor refinements to the initial data call questions with a view to supporting the data call release on January 5, 2004. These comments will be provided by separate document.

Although we have all agreed in concept that a single omnibus data call going to all respondents was the preferred way to ensure consistent data responses, I am concerned that this course of action creates certain process problems. The amount of data that will be forwarded through the certification process may make it difficult for the flag/general officer certifying officials to realistically assert the accuracy of all the data and the completeness of the process used to collect the data. Also, the volume of information contained in a single document will require a yet unidentified level of effort to extract the data from the database in report formats that will allow for meaningful analysis. This data reduction step is necessary before performing analysis and is currently being reviewed within DON, particularly from a support requirement standpoint.

We are pleased with the cooperative effort to date between all parties involved and anticipate an unprecedented level of interservice cooperation leading to the successful outcome of the process.

## ENVIRONMENTAL CAPACITY DATA CALL QUESTION REVIEW

- Review completed. Questions substantively provide a complete, macro-level accounting of major environmental programs, regulation and permit status with a focus on how environmental regulation may or may not constrain military operations.
- It is anticipated that the questions will be answered by Regional/Installation Environmental Program Managers and any activity environmental permit holders as applicable.
- The following administrative changes will need to be made:
  - All questions need to be tagged so all JCSGs receive the responses.
  - DoD # 252 and 253 needs to be amended to read “nautical” vice “statute” miles.
  - DoD #299 needs to be amended replacing “production and distribution” with “collection or treatment”; replacing “non-potable water” with “sanitary sewage”. This change has been coordinated with Army and Air Force counterparts.
  - DoD #244 needs to be amended to add a 100 ft possible expansion measure to existing ESQD arc/s. This change was proposed by Air Force and coordinated with Army and Navy.
  - The sorting Index needs to be amended to add under “Natural Resources” sections on “Wetlands”, “Marine Resources” and “Marine Sanctuaries” to account for questions in those areas; the “Operations Areas” section should be deleted. Under “Water Resources” add section entitled “Surface Water/National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES)”. Under “Encroachment”, the “Noise” section should come before “Constraints”.
  - Questions need to be properly sequenced under the Index as amended above and various typos and spelling errors corrected.
- Subject to the aforementioned corrections, the environmental portion of the capacity data call is sufficient to capture the data as briefed to the Infrastructure Evaluation Group (IEG) on 4 December 2003.

Subj: Review of Education and Training Capacity Data Call Questions

1. The Education and Training team reviewed the E&T Capacity Data Call questions and found it reasonably complete and accurate. There were three DoD questions that did not encompass the changes from the QRT and these have been corrected. I also note here areas that may be confusing in the data call, and may require a change:
  - a. DOD #18, Question (Unaccompanied Housing) begins "For USAF and Army installations," may lead installations to believe it does not pertain to Navy units. Amplification lists DoN codes, indicating Navy installations should provide input. This may be confusing.
  - b. DOD #91, 138 begins "If your installation conducts undergraduate or graduate level flight training, or you are a USN or USMC activity"; unclear why the distinction for DoN activities only has been made.
  - c. DOD #94, 95, 104, 107 questions have a phrase "All Army National Guard and Army Reserve installations/facilities that conduct Specialized Skills Training need to answer this question also." Calling those out without mentioning USMC or Air Guard facilities may be confusing. QRT representatives indicate analysis of USMC and Air Guard will be handled differently.
2. The E&T team assessment is that the E&T Capacity Data Call questions will each be responded to by all the Services with the exceptions noted here:
  - a. DOD #74 (Presence of Digital Multipurpose Range Complex) asks about an Army only system. Navy/Air Force reps did not request addition to this question during development or QRT.
  - b. DOD #182 (Physical Plant Support) starts "For Department of Navy only." Army and Air Force representatives were involved in development but decided they did not want to ask this question at QRT.
  - c. DOD #571, 572, 584, 585, 586 587, 591 were drafted as DoN questions in response to the request for service specific questions.
  - d. DOD #164 (Current Special Use Airspace for Launch and Test Ranges) Question begins "(Space Ranges Only) identify airspace associated with space launch facilities, established and utilized for launch and test operations (include aeronautical) performed either as a lead range or supporting range." Intended for space ranges only, specifically Patrick/Cape complex and Vandenburg.
3. Given the corrective actions that have already been made, the E&T Capacity Data Call questions are satisfactory to support DoN Capacity Data Call needs.

Subj: REVIEW OF HEADQUARTERS AND SUPPORT ACTIVITIES CAPACITY  
DATA CALL QUESTIONS

1. The Headquarters and Support Activities (H&SA) team reviewed the H&SA Capacity Data Call questions and found it reasonably complete and accurate. Many of the DFAS questions can and should be consolidated but is likely too late to accomplish prior to the data call going out.

2. With the exception of the Army Surge (# 61 - 68) questions, all services answer all of the questions, however some of the questions can be misleading. Most of the questions were easily understood, but recommend all questions be specifically labeled for ALL or just one service to answer. All questions should have "For all services, complete the following..." where applicable.

3. The H&SA questions are satisfactory to support DoN Capacity Data Call needs.

4. Specific recommendations for DoD numbered questions follow below:

20 - Munitions Storage is not an H&SA issue.

23 - 29 - Ensure "For all services, complete the following"

40 - Ensure "For all services, complete the following"

61 - 68 - Navy does not need to answer, these concern Army Surge which is not the same as Navy Surge

333 - same as 334 and should be deleted

347 - 444 are all DFAS and Financial Questions and need to be ALL looked at for consolidation within each specific area. Almost 100 questions and there are groups of ten or so questions that can be consolidated within one data sheet.

458 - same as 462 and needs to be deleted

459 - same as 464 and should be deleted

465 - merge with 463

466 - merge with 459

467 - merge with 463/5

486 - 487 are Industrial questions

1. A total of 53 IJCSG capacity questions were reviewed for completeness and are distributed as follows:

2. Seams and Gaps

In-Service Engineering, as identified in the attached point paper, is not addressed in the IJCSG or Technical data calls.

Five government-owned, contractor-operated facilities within the Navy are requested to answer 10 munitions and armaments questions (DOD #512-521). While the contractors will be asked by their contracting officers to answer the questions, it is expected that the response will be similar to previous BRACs, i.e., that the contractor will answer the questions if paid for the effort. Should that be the contractor's response, NAVSEA's procuring contracting officer will answer the questions to the best of his or her ability and the response will be included in NAVSEA's response to the data call. It should be noted that the Navy owns GOCO facilities, which do not fall under the purview of the Industrial area.

Insufficient alignment exists between the munitions and armament metrics identified on page 6 and 7 of the Capacity Analysis Report and the data call. Deployment network and throughput are not incorporated. In order to capture a measure of capacity, recommend the following DOD reference #s from the Supply and Storage JCSG be tagged for distribution to the Industrial JCSG: #1617, 1618, 1622, 1634, 1625, 1626, 1629, 1633, 1637, 1640, 1641, 1642, 1644, and 1645. Note: Supply and Storage activities definition must be broad enough to ensure operational level activities responsible for ordnance handling respond to the above questions.

3. Discrepancies and Inconsistencies by DOD reference number:

#516 and #517 are duplicative, delete #517.

A clear delineation is required between the maintenance questions and the munitions maintenance questions. Per page 9 of the IJCSG Capacity Analysis Report, maintenance questions cover the ordnance, missiles, and weapons commodity area less explosives; however it is not clear to the respondent. Munitions maintenance questions appear to query for the same information. The distinction between the two groups of questions must be made clearer in DOD reference #490, 495, 496, 497, 498, 499, 501, 502, 503, 504, 505, 506, 507, 508, 509, 510, 511, 520, and 521.

#520 and 521 require the addition of the MK54 Torpedo.

#512 delete unnecessary definitions per QRT session.

SUPSHIP questions require correction, as QRT action was not completed. #631 - retain, flag for Industrial JCSG; #632 - not required/delete; #633 - not required/delete.

Army questions duplicate IJCSG questions. QRT agreed to delete: #76 (501 is JCSG question to be retained), #77 (503), #78 (505), #79 (508), #80 (509), #81 (510), #82 (511), #83 (518)

4. Subject to the corrections, I believe that the capacity questions are sufficient to obtain the data briefed to the ISG.

DoD Final Capacity Questionnaire Intelligence JCSG  
IAT Intelligence Team Review – 19 Dec 03

**Background.** The Intelligence Team reviewed the draft IJCSG capacity questions (received 18 December 03). The IJCSG adopted the formats and questions from other JCSGs, and then modified them as appropriate to fit the intelligence framework. To date, there has been no formal review by an OSD-led Question Resolution Team (QRT). However, since the IJCSG utilized questions that were reviewed by the QRT of other JCSGs, this review may not yield many substantial changes. Although the subject questions could address capacity analysis, the actual approach to capacity analysis has not yet been approved by the ISG. Additionally, the ISG also has not yet approved solutions for outstanding classification issues. Until these requirements are approved, any data call to the field would be premature.

**Summary.** The Intelligence Team reviewed 50 draft DoD capacity questions of the IJCSG. All questions at this time are unclassified. Answers to the questions are to be provided at the lowest classification level possible. 18 questions cover Correlation/Collaboration/Analysis/Access (C2A2); 12 questions cover Sources and Methods; and 20 questions cover Management Activities. As many of the questions utilize tables of data, each question represents multiple inputs.

**DOD Final Capacity Questionnaire – Medical JCSG  
DON Medical Review**

1. The Medical Team has reviewed the Medical JCSG requested BRAC 2005 Capacity Data Call Questions – Final – December 2003. The 42 questions initially reviewed include 32 from the Medical JCSG with two additional questions from the Air Force, one from the Army, and seven from Navy/USMC. All questions are consistent with the planned MJCSG approach with the following corrections additions recommended:

a. DOD #11: Other Facilities (Final #693) submitted by the USAF is confusing to non-USAF activities and should be clarified if it is to be completed by all medical activities regardless of service. MJCSG reviewers have concurred and are working the required corrections through the USAF.

b. DOD #584: General Information (Final #1417) submitted by the Navy/USMC contains fields pertinent to all medical activities regardless of service. Recommend removal of Navy/USMC from the “Question” section.

c. In order to increase alignment between the Medical JCSG and other JCSGs, recommend the following DOD Reference Numbers be tagged for distribution to the Medical JCSG:

(1) Navy/Marine Corps: DOD #30.

(2) Air Force: DOD #31

(3) Headquarters and Support: DOD #s 312, 326, 338, 241, 346, 412, 450.

(4) Supply and Storage: DOD #688

(5) Technical: DOD #s 694, 696, 697, 698, 699, 700, 701, 702, 703, 704, 705, 706, 707, 708, 710, 711, 712, 713, 714, 715, 716, 717, 718, 719, 720, 721, 722, 723, 724, 725, 726, 727, 728, 730, 731, 735, 740, 746, 745, 748.

2. The indexing and order of the questions are appropriate.

3. Subject to the corrections, the capacity questions are sufficient to obtain the required data.

Subj: Review of DoN Operations Capacity Data Call Questions

1. The operations team reviewed the DoD final capacity questions using the following resources: Navy specific questions submittal to the Data Standardization Team, QRT minutes, notes and Joint Cross-Service Groups (JCSG) comments. The final questions were crosschecked against the original submission to identify questions that were eliminated or modified. The other resources identified were then used to address questions removed or modified from the Navy submission.

2. The operations team reviewed 228 final DoD capacity questions of Navy/Marine Corps operations interest and did not identify any substantive issues requiring IEG involvement. The following summarizes the questions reviewed in each operations area of interest:

a. Base Management

1) Included under base management are ten general information questions that identify the organization/activity, location, UIC tenant/host/subordinate relationships and other organizational information. These questions start with the phrase “for Navy/Marine Corps activities only” because the other services are using certified database sources to obtain this information, whereas the DoN is using the information supplied (and certified) from the units themselves.

2) There are 83 questions dealing with buildings, land, utilities and communication resources that will accurately portray the real estate footprint of every Naval activity and installation. Additionally, there are two questions that will identify the personnel, in detail, at each activity and installation.

b. Surface/Subsurface Operations. There are 11 questions that portray the capacity at each installation to berth ships, submarines and auxiliary craft with sufficient detail to allow analysis to support the principal metric of the “Cruiser Equivalent.” There are nine questions that are used to identify the requirements for ship berthing for all types of craft, with sufficient detail to support the analysis against the principal capacity metric. Additionally, two Integrated Undersea Surveillance System questions are included.

c. Airfield Operations. There are 32 questions indexed under “Base Management/Airfields,” covering air operations and airfield infrastructure (i.e. hangers, runways, ramps, and maintenance) to support the “Squadron Equivalent” metric. Of these, one question with a large table will sufficiently address the number and type of squadrons in sufficient detail to allow capacity analysis. Additionally, there are 38 questions indexed under “Education and Training” related to aircrew training, airspace and range utilization to support the analysis.

d. Ground Forces. There are 19 questions that portray the capacity at each installation to host NMCB, Special Warfare units and Marine forces to allow analysis to support the principal metric of the “Battalion equivalent.” Additionally, there are 57 questions indexed under “Education and Training” and “Base Management” related to maneuver areas, operational ranges and personnel support facilities.

3. The IAT Operations team was heavily involved in the Question Resolution Team (QRT) process that drove the final product and, therefore, remains confident that the DoD questionnaire will adequately address capacity analysis from a Navy/Marine Corps operations perspective.

Subj: Review of Supply and Storage Capacity Data Call Questions

1. The Supply and Storage team reviewed the S&S Capacity Data Call questions and found them reasonably complete and accurate. The following change recommendations are made for questions that may be confusing:
  - a. DOD#635, in the table, the 2<sup>nd</sup> column "Functional Activity" seems to duplicate the 1<sup>st</sup> column.
  - b. DOD#644, in the table, columns 3-6, should alternate fiscal years to be consistent with the rest of the table.
  - c. DOD#653, Suggest rephrasing the question to "How many Non-DoD customers DODAACs are supported by the Supply and Storage Activity by type" for clarity.
2. The S&S team assessment is that all S&S Capacity Data Call questions will be responded to by all of the Services and appropriate DoD agencies.
3. While the S&S Capacity Data Call questions are satisfactory to support DoN Capacity Data Call needs, the following concerns are raised:
  - a. The capacity data call is very comprehensive, and it focuses largely on current S&S performance information. How current performance will be linked to current capacity is unclear. Without current capacity it will be difficult to determine excess capacity.
  - b. There is no currently defined structure for analyzing the data received.
  - c. For BRAC decision-makers to decide how to best reconfigure the physical infrastructure, the elemental functional capacities have to be tied to major physical resources. The capacity data call does not currently allow making these linkages.

### Executive Summary for the Technical JCSG Capacity Data Call

The Technical portion of the capacity data call was reviewed and found generally sufficient and in compliance with the Technical JCSG Capacity Analysis Report. Following are comments regarding the data call questions.

#### General

- A large part of the data call contains questions associated with “intellectual/human capital”, including education levels, patents, awards, etc. A methodology for analyzing this type of information to establish capacity is not included in the Capacity Report nor has it been established outside of that report. A great potential exists for gathering large amounts of data that cannot be used for capacity analysis.
- The multiple questions dealing with Information Systems are both deficient and inconsistent in their description of the subject matter to be covered, particularly C4ISR. These questions need appropriate modification.
- The designations of “Air Combat”, “Sea Combat” and “Ground Combat” in several questions connote work done ONLY on combat systems vice logistics and other support systems. All of these systems are dealt with but that is not clear in the questions. Suggest clarification be provided.

#### Specific

- Question #85 duplicates question #686.
- In the table for question #686, change all “yes/no” questions to include “days used” by fiscal year. This provides usable capacity information at the appropriate level.
- It is unclear how question #689 can be used to measure capacity, because there are large variations within ACAT programs and the assets needed to manage and execute them.
- The table in question #733 is a duplicate of that in question #732. It should be modified appropriately.


