In compliance with both the Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD) Internal Control Plan (ICP) for the Base Realignment and Closure Process, Appendix B to Under Secretary of Defense (Acquisition, Technology and Logistics) Memorandum "Transformation Through Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC 2005) Policy Memorandum One – Policy, Responsibilities, and Procedures," dated 16 April 2003, and the Department of Navy Procedures for Certification of BRAC 2005 Information, enclosure (1) to the Secretary of the Navy Memorandum "Internal Control Plan for Management of the Department of the Navy 2005 Base Closure and Realignment (BRAC) Process Policy Advisory Two," dated 27 June 2003, this memorandum is a certification of Department of the Navy (DON) data provided to the Joint Cross Service Groups (JCSGs) for their use in analyzing common business support functions. The data consists of capacity data for detachments and remote sites that were reported in aggregate for the activities to which they report. The sites for which data is provided are summarized in enclosure (1). The data itself is provided as enclosure (2) in order to provide detail below the activity level that was not allowed by the question format. To ensure consistency of certified data, this office has reconciled data totals for the activities with the data in enclosure (2), and these reconciled totals will be reflected in our next regular submission of data updates.

We are providing this disaggregated data in this format to support its analysis by the Industrial JCSG as quickly as possible. Based upon direction received from the Industrial JCSG working groups concerning which activities and detachments are of interest to the JCSG, the DON BRAC office will expand its list of activities to include all detachments that will be analyzed by the JCSG. Once that occurs, this same data will be incorporated into our master data set so that the data will be forwarded in our regular updates at a future date.

Subject to the foregoing, I certify that the information is accurate and complete to the best of my knowledge and belief.
