SUBJECT: ARMAMENTS PRODUCTION AND MANUFACTURING

Your memorandum dated 1 Oct 2004 concerning Armaments Production and Manufacturing requested Navy concurrence to eliminate the following two activities from further Armaments Production and Manufacturing analysis by the Industrial Joint Cross Service Group:

- Naval Weapons Station Charleston, South Carolina
- Naval Air Station Joint Reserve Base Willow Grove, Pennsylvania

Navy concurs with your request as stated above. To ensure that our actions do not unintentionally result in an activity being removed entirely from analysis, with the consequence that no deliberative body analyzes it, I have confirmed with the Department of Navy Infrastructure Analysis Team that DON's deliberative bodies are analyzing NAS JRB WILLOW GROVE. Your memorandum of 1 Oct 2004 concerning Munitions Storage and Distribution Sites, confirms that the Armaments and Munitions Sub-Group continues to analyze WPNSTA CHARLESTON SC for the primary function it performs.
