- **Close Ft Monroe**
  - Headquarters TRADOC to Ft Eustis VA
  - Accessions Command & Cadet Command to Ft Knox, KY to help form Human Resources Center of Excellence
  - Joint Task Force – Civil Support to be determined
  - Northeast Region Installation Management Agency to Ft Eustis, VA
  - Army Contracting Agency Northern Region to Ft Eustis, VA
- **Realign schools at 3 installations to create new training centers of excellence**
  - Maneuver Center (Armor & Infantry) at Ft Benning, GA
  - Net Fires Center (Air Defense & Artillery) at Ft Sill, OK
  - Combat Service Support Center (Quartermaster, Transportation & Ordnance) at Ft Lee, VA
- **Consolidate drill sergeant schools from 3 (Knox, Leonard Wood, Jackson) to 1 (Jackson)**
- **Create center for joint religious education at Ft Jackson, SC**
- **Realign Aviation Logistics School from Ft Eustis, VA to Ft Rucker, AL**
- **Align garrison operations from Ft Eustis to Air Force and Ft Story to Navy**


**TRADOC HQ:**

- It appears that the DoD plan is for TRADOC to use existing buildings at Fort Eustis with some construction. Is this your understanding of the plan and does this seem reasonable?
- Did DoD adequately assess the BRAC criteria with regard to TRADOC and Fort Monroe?
- Should the Commissioners consider any changes to the recommendation concerning TRADOC and or Fort Monroe/ Fort Eustis since the final recommendation will become legally binding if these recommendations are sustained by the Commission, President and the Congress?
- Is the data reflected in the DoD report accurate and if not can you provide the Commission with the accurate data?
- Are there any known deficiencies that you know of in the Fort Eustis infrastructure that may have not been considered by DoD that could impact TRADOC's relocation?
- What are the issues that you expect the state of VA will surface before taking control of the Fort Monroe property?
- The recommendation does not address a number of small activities currently at Fort Monroe and DoD has them in a category called Base X. Does the Command know where these activities will go?


**ACCESSIONS COMMAND/CADET COMMAND:**


