TECHNOLOGY AND LOGISTICS), CHAIRMAN,
INFRASTRUCTURE STEERING GROUP

SUBJECT: Request to Increase Membership of the Supply & Storage Joint Cross-
Service Group

1. Your March 15, 2003, memorandum directed the Supply & Storage Joint Cross-Service Group (S&S JCSG) to complete a broad, comprehensive look at DOD supply and storage capabilities and capacities. The S&S JCSG conducted our initial meeting in order to comply with our taskings due to the Infrastructure Steering Group by March 31, 2003. We quickly came to the conclusion that any meaningful, thorough look at all Services and DOD capabilities and capacities could not be accomplished without significant participation and analysis by the Defense Logistics Agency.
2. Accordingly, we request your authorization to add the Commander, Defense Logistics Agency, or his designee, as a full member of the S&S JCSG.
