MEMORANDUM FOR DIRECTOR, BASE REALIGNMENT AND CLOSURE

SUBJECT: Transformational Options for BRAC 2005

In his 8 Sep 04 memorandum, same subject, Mr. Wynne asked each Joint Cross Service Group (JCSG) chairman to formally concur with and comment on the list of transformational options (TOs) he provided in his attachment. Along with the TOs, the attachment listed the Source and Application of each one and categorized them with a recommendation for approval or deletion that would be forwarded to the Infrastructure Executive Council. I concur with the list as written.

While we waited for the final comments on the transformational options, we continued to move forward with a deliberate eye towards developing smart ideas and proposals that reduced excess infrastructure within the Supply and Storage area of responsibility. We continue to pursue intelligent courses of action to reduce excess capacity while ensuring fiscal responsibility, improved warfighter efficiency and effectiveness, and transformation.

Your memorandum listed five transformational options recommended for approval that applied to the Supply and Storage JCSG. Additionally, upon a closer review of the other transformational options that were also recommended for approval, we see an opportunity to leverage a number of them with some of our own. As a result, I believe this will enable us to further achieve our goals.
