SUBJECT: Deletion of Supply & Services (S&S)-0030, Realign Storage and Distribution Functions at Sierra Army Depot

This is to inform you that in deliberative session on February 14, 2005, the S&S Principal members of the S&S Joint Cross-Service Group curtailed further effort on scenario S&S-0030 and deleted the scenario in the Office of the Secretary of Defense Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) Tracking Tool. Further, in deliberative session on March 8, 2005, the S&S Principals learned that the Army continues to define its future post-transformation storage requirements at Sierra. As a result, a clear determination of Army requirements is not available for S&S to facilitate our analysis of the Sierra Army Depot during this BRAC effort.
