Candidate Recommendation #HSA0018: Realigns the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS)

Candidate Recommendation #HSA0031R: Realigns Defense Agency leased facilities/installations at DeCA, WHS, DISA and DoDEA, Arlington, VA and consolidates transactional functions at DSCC

Candidate Recommendation #S&S0035RV2: Transfers procurement management and funding of service DLRs and management of remaining consumables to DLA
