

Summary of Cumulative Environmental Impacts

Naval Air Station Jacksonville, FL

1. DONCR-0041R: Realign COMNAVREG Gulf Coast, COMNAVREG Southeast, COMNAVREG South, COMNAVREG Southwest, and COMNAVREG Northwest at Various Locations.
2. DONCR-0074R: Close/Consolidate NAVFAC EFD with NAVFAC EFA, and Relocate NAVCRANCEN, Lester, PA.
3. DONCR-0138R: Realign NAS Brunswick, ME to a NAF and Relocate All Squadrons to NAS Jacksonville, FL.
4. INDCR103R: Establish Fleet Readiness Centers.

Environmental Resource Area	Naval Air Station Jacksonville, FL (Gaining Installation)
Air Quality	NAS Jacksonville is in maintenance for Ozone (1- hr). No impact. NO _x total is above 1-hour threshold. County will be in attainment in June 05.
Cultural/Archeological/ Tribal Resources	DONCR-0074R - Historic property and archeological sites identified, may impact new MILCON.
Dredging	No impact.
Land Use Constraints/ Sensitive Resource Areas	No impact.
Marine Mammals/Marine Resources/Marine Sanctuaries	No impact.
Noise	DONCR-0138R - Results in less impact compared to the baseline noise contour due to the planned disestablishment of the S-3 community.
Threatened & Endangered Species/Critical Habitat	DONCR-0138R - TES present. No impact.
Waste Management	DONCR-0074R and DON-0138R - Increase waste disposal requirements.
Water Resources	All scenarios - Discharge to an impaired waterway. Increase water consumption, but installation has sufficient water resources to accommodate.
Wetlands	DONCR-0074R – Wetland presence will be consideration for new MILCON.
