MEETING SUMMARY: This meeting was coordinated through Ms Christine Hill (BRAC Legislative Affairs). The Hawaii Congressional Staffers requested this meeting to get a better understanding of the BRAC Commission "Adds" process as related to the possible addition of the NSY & IMF Pearl Harbor to the list of Base Realignment and Closure candidates. Specific issues/concerns included:

- Timeline and process for providing information to the Commission for analysis
- Evaluation process used by the Commission once data is provided
- How dry-docks will be factored into the analysis
- Data already provided to the Commission by Naval Shipyard Portsmouth Community

The delegation was informed by the Commission Staff that the NSY & IMF Pearl Harbor was not actually on the list of realignment/closure candidate installations until voted on at the 19 July 2005 BRAC Commission Adds Hearing, and if added, would be afforded the same opportunities for data submission and BRAC analysis as all other facilities on the DOD recommendation list.
