SUBJECT: Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) Update

This is the sixth of my weekly status reports.

Time Remaining: Effectively, 32 days remain until you provide your BRAC recommendations to the Commission and Congress (and publish them in the Federal Register) by Monday, May 16th, the statutory deadline. We expect to hold a press conference on the Friday before the statutory deadline.

Commissioners/Organization Now that the Commissioners have all been appointed, their organization work can begin in earnest. We have provided the Commission with office space in Crystal City and DoD's FY05 budget included \$10 million for their operations. We will do everything we can to support them while maintaining the appropriate arms-length relationship.

Current Status of Candidate Recommendations (TABs A and B): Of the 393 Candidate Recommendations under consideration, the DepSecDef's Infrastructure Executive Council has "tentatively" approved 353 to date, and either it or the subordinate Infrastructure Steering Group have disapproved 5.

- Major Closures: 25 with work distributed to ~77 locations
- Minor Closures: ~491 with work distributed to ~270 locations
- Major Realignments: ~105 with work distributed to a few hundred locations

Financial Considerations: The 20-year Net Present Value from all candidate recommendations received to date: \$45.7 Billion (see TAB C).

- We continue to watch the financials closely. Please note that the first column of the slide at TAB C indicates "Gross Savings" which is a sum of one-time costs and the 20 year Net Present Value. This provides a rough approximation of the total savings – approximately \$90 billion (including overseas savings).

"Knitting" Candidate Recommendations: We are currently in the candidate recommendation "knitting" process. This process involves allocating the costs and savings among recommendations and combining multiple candidate recommendations



into a single candidate recommendation where that makes functional, strategic, or financial sense.

- This process has the added benefit of illustrating the stand-alone “orphan” candidate recommendations that need particular focus – that is, those that may have poor financials individually and are not directly tied to implementing a larger strategy. Currently, 134 or about a third of the 388 candidate recommendations now in play yield a negative 20-year Net Present Value. The listing at TAB D arrays these in descending net present value order with associated one-time costs, payback years, and annual recurring savings also indicated. Of these, about 20 appear to be in this “orphan” category and we are focusing on them.
 - BRAC is a key catalyst for transformation and when we use it to create new capabilities, it often produces costs. Those candidates that cannot be tied to strategies or provide significant non-monetary military benefits will be closely scrutinized before they are recommended for your final approval.

BRAC Roll-Out: Dick McGraw is heading up a tiger team for the roll out of your BRAC recommendations.

- **Emerging Themes:** For themes, we are starting with your BRAC “kick-off” memo (TAB E) along with the BRAC principles signed out by the Deputy (TAB F) and the overarching strategies of the Services and Joint Cross Service Groups.
 - Jointness
 - Analytical structure joint at every level
 - Joint Cross service groups backbone of the effort
 - Joint business solutions
 - Transformation
 - Integration of overseas actions
 - Annual recurring savings
- Some key issues that will be highlighted within the above:
 - Supply Chain Management to consolidate and streamline maintenance and inventory (lean, just-in-time, and e-commerce; medical initiatives to consolidate activities under joint management while incorporating modern techniques emphasizing outpatient care;
 - Technology and Lab consolidation in ‘Centers of Excellence’ to focus the Department’s investment;
 - recognition of Force Protection realities to consolidate outlying, mostly leased facilities onto active bases that can share the protection overhead; and
 - Re-deploying force structure to reflect new agility needs and technologies.

Calendar Demands: As we discussed at our last meeting, I have arranged for the Military Departments to individually discuss their BRAC programs with you. The Navy will appear first on April 7th, followed by the Air Force on April 8th and the Army on April 15th. The papers at TABs G and H provide an overview of the Navy and Air Force

BRAC programs and observations that should assist you in your preparations for those meetings. I will provide similar information for the Army next week.

- These are information meetings. In future meetings where your decisions will be required, we will ensure that we adhere to the BRAC process so that where you exercise your authority to provide direction, we will ensure the record (which will be reviewed by the Commission) is appropriately documented.
- In previous meetings, I have provided in depth information on some of the significant issues listed at TAB I. I will continue to do this, as time permits. The most significant issue currently under review is highlighted – it concerns the management and acquisition of depot-level reparable. This controversial issue provides some of the best potential for financial return of any recommendation.

Subject: Transformation Through Base Realignment and Closure

As a result of the Quadrennial Defense Review, we embarked on a comprehensive review of our defense and security needs toward transforming the force. New force structures must be accompanied by a new base structure. The first step was my request to the Chairman to direct the geographic combatant commanders to prepare, in coordination with their Service component commands, draft overseas basing plans for their respective areas of responsibility.

Congress authorized a base realignment and closure (BRAC) round in 2005. At a minimum, BRAC 2005 must eliminate excess physical capacity; the operation, sustainment and recapitalization of which diverts scarce resources from defense capability. However, BRAC 2005 can make an even more profound contribution to transforming the Department by rationalizing our infrastructure with defense strategy. BRAC 2005 should be the means by which we reconfigure our current infrastructure into one in which operational capacity maximizes *both* warfighting capability and efficiency. I am directing this process begin immediately, under the structure set out herein.

Two senior groups, as reflected in the attachment, will oversee and operate the BRAC 2005 process. The Infrastructure Executive Council (IEC), chaired by the Deputy Secretary, and composed of the Secretaries of the Military Departments and their Chiefs of Services, the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff and Under Secretary of Defense (Acquisition, Technology and Logistics) (USD(AT&L)), will be the policy making and oversight body for the entire BRAC 2005 process.

The subordinate Infrastructure Steering Group (ISG), chaired by the USD(AT&L) and composed of the Vice Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, the Military Department Assistant Secretaries for installations and environment, the Service Vice Chiefs, and the Deputy Under Secretary of Defense (Installations & Environment) (DUSD(I&E)), will oversee joint cross-service analyses of common business oriented functions and ensure the integration of that process with the Military Department and Defense Agency specific analyses of all other functions. The USD(AT&L) will have the authority and responsibility for issuing the operating policies and detailed direction necessary to conduct the BRAC 2005 analyses.

A primary objective of BRAC 2005, in addition to realigning our base structure to meet our post-Cold War force structure, is to examine and implement opportunities for greater joint activity. Prior BRAC analyses considered all functions on a service-by-service basis and, therefore, did not result in the joint examination of functions that cross services. While some unique functions may exist, those functions that are common across the Services must be analyzed on a joint basis.

Accordingly, the BRAC 05 analysis will be divided into two categories of functions.

- Joint cross-service teams will analyze the common business-oriented support functions and report their results through the ISG to the IEC.
- The Military Departments will analyze all service unique functions and report their results directly to the IEC.

Within 150 days of this memorandum, the ISG will recommend to the IEC the specific functions to receive joint analysis and the metrics for that analysis for my approval. The Military Departments through their representatives on the ISG, as well as the Defense Agencies, should communicate regularly with the ISG to ensure that their recommendations are fully consistent with the joint cross-service teams' recommendations.

A comprehensive infrastructure rationalization requires an analysis that examines a wide range of options for stationing and supporting forces and functions, rather than simply reducing capacity in a status-quo configuration. To that end, in accordance with the force structure plan and selection criteria, the ISG will recommend to the IEC for my approval a broad series of options for stationing and supporting forces and functions to increase efficiency and effectiveness. The Military Department and the joint cross-service analytical teams must consider all options endorsed by the IEC in the course of their analysis. The analytical teams may consider additional options, but they may not modify or dismiss those endorsed by the IEC without my approval.

In accordance with section 2909 of BRAC 90, as amended, BRAC 2005, as directed by this memorandum, will be the exclusive means for selecting for closure or realignment, or for carrying out any closure or realignment of, a military installation located in the United States until April 15, 2006. This exclusivity clause does not apply to closures and realignments to which section 2687 of title 10, United States Code, is not applicable. Closures or realignments to which section 2687 is not applicable will require approval on the basis of guidance issued by the USD(AT&L). Competitive sourcing conducted under the provisions of OMB Circular A-76 may proceed independently.

In accordance with the direction of Congress expressed in the BRAC legislation, the Department will not make any binding closure or realignment decisions prior to the submission of final recommendations to the Commission no later than May 15, 2005. The process and structure outlined in this memorandum are designed to ensure the Department's ability to provide recommendations by this date and to meet several interim statutory requirements, including publishing draft selection criteria by December 31, 2003, and final criteria by February 16, 2004. In addition, the Department must provide Congress a force structure plan, inventory, capacity analysis, and certification of the need for BRAC with the FY 2005 budget documentation.



BRAC 2005 Organization




BRAC 2005 Leadership

SUBJECT: BRAC 2005 Military Value Principles

The Department has determined that the most appropriate way to ensure that military value is the primary consideration in making closure and realignment recommendations is to determine military value through the exercise of military judgment built upon a quantitative analytical foundation. By applying the BRAC selection criteria to rank the facilities for which they have responsibility, the Joint Cross-Service Groups and the Military Departments build the quantitative analytical foundation. The exercise of military judgment occurs through the application of the attached principles. Limited in number and written broadly, the principles enumerate the essential elements of military judgment to be applied in the BRAC process. The Military Departments and the Joint Cross-Service Groups shall use the principles when applying military judgment in their deliberative processes.

BRAC Principles

Recruit and Train: The Department must attract, develop, and retain active, reserve, civilian, and contractor personnel who are highly skilled and educated and have access to effective, diverse, and sustainable training space in order to ensure current and future readiness, to support advances in technology, and to respond to anticipated developments in joint and service doctrine and tactics.

Quality of Life: The Department must provide a quality of life, including quality of work place that supports recruitment, learning, and training, and enhances retention.

Organize: The Department needs force structure sized, composed, and located to match the demands of the National Military Strategy, effectively and efficiently supported by properly aligned headquarters and other DoD organizations, and that takes advantage of opportunities for joint basing.

Equip: The Department needs research, development, acquisition, test, and evaluation capabilities that efficiently and effectively place superior technology in the hands of the warfighter to meet current and future threats and facilitate knowledge-enabled and net-centric warfare.

Supply, Service, and Maintain: The Department needs access to logistical and industrial infrastructure capabilities optimally integrated into a skilled and cost efficient national industrial base that provides agile and responsive global support to operational forces.

Deploy & Employ (Operational): The Department needs secure installations that are optimally located for mission accomplishment (including homeland defense), that support power projection, rapid deployable capabilities, and expeditionary force needs for reach-back capability, that sustain the capability to mobilize and surge, and that ensure strategic redundancy.

Intelligence: The Department needs intelligence capabilities to support the National Military Strategy by delivering predictive analysis, warning of impending crises, providing persistent surveillance of our most critical targets, and achieving horizontal integration of networks and databases.

BRAC Strategies

- Eliminate excess infrastructure, while balancing the evolving force structure, organizational alignment changes, and AT/FP redundancy considerations
- Leverage opportunities for total force laydown/joint basing

Issues/Questions

- The Navy has set the bar high for payback, implying that they are “BRACing to a budget”. This type of approach can limit BRAC’s transformation potential. For example:
 - NAS Oceana, VA (Encroachment and operating constraints remain unresolved)
 - MCAS Beaufort, NC (Could be closed but retained as a back-up for Oceana)
 - Marine Corps Recruit Depot San Diego, CA (This boot camp is operationally encroached but its consolidation into Parris Island, SC, requires investment.)
- Initiatives impacting the Northeast and Central/West Gulf Coast. Potential closures of NAS Brunswick, ME; Portsmouth Shipyard, ME; and Submarine Base New London, CT, effectively eliminate (with the exception of Newport, RI) the Navy’s presence in the Northeast and, as such, could impact reserve/active recruiting. Similarly, potential closures of Naval Stations at Pascagoula, MS, and Ingleside, TX, could have the same effect on the Central/West Gulf Coast (with the exception of a small presence in New Orleans, LA).
- Global Posture – It looks as though the Navy will decide to make its carrier stationing decision outside of the BRAC process
- Worked closely with joint cross-service groups, but leaned toward service centric rather than joint solutions
 - Reserve Headquarters
 - Military Personnel Centers
 - Senior Service Colleges
- Opposes helicopter training consolidation from NAS Whiting Field, FL, to Ft Rucker, AL

BRAC Strategies

- Uncover excess infrastructure while maintaining long range strike, strategic response, force protection, proximity to training , and air sovereignty capability
- Optimize squadron aircraft/crew ratios and the location of Reserve/Guard units

Issues/Questions

- The Air Force is eliminating some operating base excess capacity but overall it is protecting most of its operational assets through force realignment
- The Air Force is making significant (and costly) Guard/Reserve changes that move or eliminate aircraft but leave enclaves for different missions, while maximizing force structure on “active” bases.
 - 22 Air Guard Station closures
 - 2 build more facilities, resulting in an increase of Plant Replacement Value
 - 14 retain approximately 1/3 of the otherwise closed facilities
- 56 Air Force Candidate Recommendations relocate ~787 aircraft from 49 to 89 locations
 - Some candidate recommendations illustrate Air Bases left underutilized, (e.g., Mountain Home AFB: 36 aircraft assigned but capacity for 96)
- Worked closely with joint cross-service groups, but leaned toward service centric rather than joint solutions
 - Reserve Headquarters
 - Military Personnel Centers
 - Senior Service Colleges
 - Undergraduate flight training
- Pushed for the inclusion of questionable military construction and other costs into joint cross service group candidate recommendations, often resulting in unattractive options (e.g., required Los Angeles AFB, CA, contractors to be relocated with base).
- Capacity and Military Value analyses questioned by the Red Team – Air Force capacity analysis appears to have arrayed wings assigned to bases by policy decisions vice a bottom-up review. Military Value analysis appears to have placed priority on the importance of assigned aircraft over the value of the facility without regard to the forces currently stationed there.
