**MEETING SUMMARY:**

1. The community explains the importance of the Life Cycle Management concept which integrates Army Acquisition, Logistics, and Technology responsibilities, authorities, and processes to provide the best support to warfighters for Soldier and Ground Systems in one location.
2. The community also reviewed the re-run of the COBRA analysis which includes 358 additional positions than reported in DoD recommendation to transfer to Detroit, MI. In the re-run the community expressed concerns about the increase cost to move personnel from Rock Island Arsenal, IL to Detroit, MI and the increase MILCON dollars to build at Detroit.
