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I work at the Red River Army Depot
in Texarkana, Tx. I am employed by the
Defense Logistics Agency. I am a veteran
& have 28 yrs of civil service to
our nation. As a soldier, I can
attest to the fact that receiving supplies
from this complex was very reassuring.

Our footprint covers almost 40,000
acres which includes Repair & maintenance
facilities for the Bradley Tank, Multiple Launch
Rocket System, Humvees, Hummit Vehicles.
We also have a ~~modern~~ modern
Distribution facility that supplies materials
to every branch of our military in
every part of the world where American
Military forces are deployed.

We also have LSAP located next
to us. They are the only facility in
the United States that produces the fuse
that goes into the M67 Hand Grenade.
We also have the only facility in
the U.S. that reassembles the tire
& road wheel assembly for all of
our tracked vehicles.

We also have an excellent
facility that recertifies the Patriot Missile.

I realize that restructuring our defense system is necessary to assure that we are implementing the most cost efficient measures. I also feel that closing these two facilities and eliminating them from our ability to supply troops with these one-of-a-kind operations is not in their best interest or that of the U.S. soldiers and our allies.

The plan to move our remanufacture of road wheels & track to Alabama seems a bit risky. It is the only one that the DOD has. Alabama is often in the path of hurricanes that hit the coast.

I believe our troops are going to be fighting this war on terror well into the next three decades ~~I believe~~ OR more. At a time when we have lost almost 2,000 soldiers in battle, it does NOT seem prudent to disassemble such a large configuration of war fighting facilities that have such a ~~diverse~~ an important part in helping to keep our soldiers alive.

I urge you to please reconsider the DOD's plan to close these facilities
