MEMORANDUM FOR CHAIRMAN, INFRASTRUCTURE STEERING GROUP

SUBJECT: Coordination on Scenario Conflicts Proposed Resolutions (Yr Memo, 25 Oct 04)

We have reviewed all of the submitted Scenario Conflicts and the Proposed Resolutions that you have recommended for each of these scenarios. The Air Force concurs with the proposed resolutions shown in the tab sections labeled "Prior ISG Conflicts" and Proposed Removal of Conflict."

For the scenarios quad charts contained in the section titled "Conflicts Settled," we suggest a review of the current approach of settling these scenario conflicts by simply requesting the MILDEP or JCSG to identify an alternate installation to solve their scenario requirement. In many of the identified "conflicts," two scenarios select the same installation, but not necessarily the same facility type. They might not conflict although they both consolidate functions on the same base. For future "Conflict" scenarios, we request the DAS's first obtain additional information on the operational and/or facility requirements needed to support their scenarios, prior to recommending a proposed resolution. Additionally, the Air Force proposes that, in the near future, each ISG agenda include some time for the MILDEPs to comment on JCSG scenarios that might conflict with existing doctrinal or operational requirements.
