TECHNICAL CORRECTION TO DESIGNATE DDRT AS THE SDP FOR THE
CENTRAL REGION

The initial DoD analysis rated the Defense Distribution Depot at Red River (DDRT) as the number one choice for assignment as the Strategic Distribution Platform for the Central Region, a mission they are essentially performing today. However, when Red River was recommend for closure, the mission was slated to move to Oklahoma City which has a lower military value.

Now that Defense Distribution Depot Red River is to remain open, they should be redesignated as the Strategic Distribution Platform (SDP) for the Central Region.

Proposed language for the "technical correction": In view of the fact that Defense Distribution Depot Red River is to remain open, and the fact that the DoD intended DDRT to be the Strategic Distribution Platform for the Central Region prior to the decision to close Red River, it is the intention of this Commission that Defense Distribution Depot Red River be designated as the Strategic Distribution Platform for the Central Region in lieu of lower rated center at Oklahoma City, OK.
