SUBJECT: Request for Audit of BRAC Facility Analysis Capability Tool

The BRAC Facility Analysis Capability (BFAC) tool is a planned capability to enhance our ability to manage infrastructure and will be used as an analytical tool during the Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) 2005 process. The Bases and Units Branch, Programs Division, Air Force Civil Engineer (AF/ILEPB) is the functional proponent for BFAC. BFAC will interface with the BRAC data collection system, WIDGET, and the base cost model, COBRA.

We are requesting an audit to determine the availability and suitability of BFAC for BRAC 2005 use. Specifically,

Does the BFAC development and test schedule support BRAC 2005 use?

Do BFAC analytical functions meet DoD modeling requirements?

Do BFAC interfaces provide secure passing of data from WIDGET and to COBRA?

Will BFAC controls and security adequately protect BRAC data?
