The committee recommends modifying current BRAC law to ensure that the 2005 BRAC round results in a national inventory of installations capable of supporting a Base Force-size military that is stationed entirely within the United States. Finally, the committee recommends requiring the Secretary of Defense to name at least half of the nation's installations as essential to national defense. This list of installations would be eliminated from BRAC commission consideration for closure or realignment. Sec. 2842.
