Subject: DAGSI Course Duplication

Lesia,

I want to clarify the comment I made at our meeting about the non-duplication of courses offered by members of the Dayton Area Graduate Studies Institute (DAGSI).

The DAGSI agreement does not deal with course offering coordination. It is an arrangement for students to be able to take courses from DAGSI partners.

However, one of the goals of DAGSI is to reduce duplication of course offerings among the DAGSI members. The member universities do work together to avoid offering similar courses or to avoid scheduling similar courses during the same season.

So, if I gave the impression there was no duplication among DAGSI members in course offerings, or that this was part of the basic DAGSI agreement, that wasn't correct. Still, under DAGSI, some duplication of courses is avoided.
