SUBJECT: Final Review of the JCSG Military Value Analysis Reports

1. I appreciate the opportunity to review the draft JCSG Military Value (MV) Analysis Reports and recommended changes. In general, we found the reports with changes sufficiently detailed to understand the JCSGs' MV approaches; the revised approaches are adequate to the task.
2. We understand that the JCSGs will be responsible for their MV questions, determining their targeted audience for their questions, appropriate references and amplification, as well as the formulas that support their questions. The Army will assist the JCSGs by ensuring the questions are worded clearly, complete, and supported by the Army data tool. I completely support this data standardization process.
3. The E&T JCSG MV Memo states, "The ISG is also pleased that E&T JCSG Chair and the Technical JCSG Chair have signed a Memorandum of Agreement to codify coordination between the two groups in relation to open-air ranges." The Army recommends that this statement also be added to the Technical JCSG Final Memo.
4. The Army has no additional comments to offer regarding the JCSG MV reports.
5. TABS looks forward to continuing to work with the JCSGs on MV and other efforts.
