MEMORANDUM FOR BRAC DIRECTOR, OUSD(I&E)

SUBJECT: ISG Meeting Minutes for 9 and 23 April 2004

The Army has reviewed the minutes for the subject ISGs. We concur with the minutes for the 9 April session.

I have discussed the 23 April minutes with GEN Casey and he recalls that the E&T JCSG would not evaluate graduate flight training for the H-60 and C-12 platforms. GEN Casey recalls that the ISG noted (as mentioned in the draft minutes) that "while the basic platform of the H-60 may be similar, their missions are significantly different among the services." The implication is that graduate flight training is so different for these aircraft that a joint look under the auspices of the JCSG would not be fruitful.

The Army believes the minutes should state, "Evaluation of graduate flight training for the H-60 and C-12 platforms is remanded to the individual services to review, as appropriate."
