- Army's distribution Hub for "Go to War" and replenishment of Chemical Defense Equipment
- Demilitarization facility for land mines
- Special Operations contract facility for modification of aircraft
- Provide "To Accompany Troops" basic load for the 160th Special Operations Aviation Regiment within 8 hours
