BRAC RECOMMENDATION

- **Realign Fort Eustis, VA by relocating the Transportation Center and School to Fort Lee, VA**
- **Realign Aberdeen Proving Ground, MD by relocating the Ordnance Mechanical Maintenance School to Fort Lee, VA**
- **Realign Redstone Arsenal, AL, by relocating the Munitions and Electronics Maintenance School to Fort Lee, VA**
- **Consolidate the Transportation Center and School and the Ordnance Center and Schools with the Quartermaster Center and School, the Army Logistics Management College, and Combined Arms Support Command**


CG CASCOM Guidance
