SUBJECT: Scenarios

1. Request that you delete scenarios for Closure of Red River Army Depot and Letterkenny Army Depot. Both Installations are in the Army's Military Value Portfolio. The GWOT induced workload is expected to remain high and these Depots are needed to support this workload.
2. Request that you delete the scenario for closure of Lima Army Tank Plant. The Army's Future Combat System acquisition strategy includes manufacturing manned vehicle chassis at Lima Army Tank Plant. Additional considerations are the United States Marine Corps' plan to use Lima for manufacturing of their expeditionary force vehicle and the need for the flexibility to accomplish a M1 tank recapitalization program.
3. We also recommend that you analyze the following options for Lima - full privatization, existing GOCO relationship, and a possible recompetition of the contract to recognize future mission and "rightsizing".
