Dear Chairman Principi,

As the Commission undertakes the enormous task of sorting through the base closures and realignments proposed by the Pentagon, I would strongly encourage you to schedule a Commissioner's site visit for the Idaho Air Guard Station at the Boise Air Terminal.

The Pentagon has recommended distributing all four C-130H aircraft from the 124th Wing to the 153rd Airlift Wing in Cheyenne, Wyoming. This move would eliminate a significant portion of the National Guard's airlift capabilities in the Pacific Northwest and have a considerable impact on our ability to protect and assist our citizens in the case of natural or manmade disaster.

The projected savings for this recommendation over a 20-year period amounts to only \$1.7 million.

Given the significant impact this recommendation has on our ability to provide tactical airlift support to the Pacific Northwest, coupled with the relatively small cost savings, I would urge you to send a Commissioner to personally review the site.
