**EDUCATION AND TRAINING JOINT CROSS-SERVICE GROUP
MEETING MINUTES OF 06 AUGUST 2004**

The Principal Deputy Under Secretary of Defense (P&R), Mr. Abell, chaired the 21st meeting of the E&T JCSG. Attendee List is at Attachment 1. Mr. Abell welcomed the E&T JCSG principals and subgroup chairmen and stated the purpose of this meeting was to discuss the subgroups' status on requests for clarification and to review notional scenarios prior to forwarding to the ISG for the 6 Aug meeting.

Each subgroup chair or representative (RADM George Mayer, Col Lynes, Maj Gen Fraser, and Mr. Harrison) reported the status of their Requests for Clarification (RFCs) and related capacity data collection issues. Mr Abell remarked that the actions taken by the subgroups appeared passive given the comments. All agreed the Services were working to get the correct information to the subgroups. It was also noted that in selected incidences, the Services have submitted data to OSD, but there seems to be a process issue that delays getting the information to the JCSG. Subgroups were asked to review the status of each RFC, particularly of those over four weeks, and provide specifics on the delay of information and actions that were taken to correct the problem. Mr. Abell requested an update at the next meeting.

The discussion then focused on scenario development and the subgroups notional scenarios. Members were concerned that these notional scenarios would become mandated scenarios from the ISG; although the intent was for training purposes only. Capacity and military value data has not been received, so the optimization models are not available to aid scenario development. Mr Buzzell, OSD-BRAC, advised that the optimization model could be run without all the capacity data but not without military value data. Practice scenarios were derived from draft transformational options and may not be viable scenario candidates after the capacity and military value data are received and analyzed. Subgroups chairs were asked to:

- ***Forward issues/concerns/recommendations about scenario development to Mr. Bob Howlett or Col Nancy Weaver, E&T JCSG Coordination Team. These will be discussed at the next meeting.***
- ***Lock down participants on the subgroup that will be involved in scenario development phase. Let principals know if there are any issues/problems.***
- ***Be mindful the workload and time required by participants at all levels will get intense in the coming weeks and months, so prepare accordingly.***
- ***Remind everyone in the process to treat discussions/results as "close-hold information."***

Mr. Abell said subgroups should be proud of the work performed on developing the notional scenarios especially given the short suspense. ***The E&T JCSG approved***

forwarding the subgroups' notional scenarios (Attachment 2) with the following modifications:

- ***PDE: Add JPME workarounds as a potential constraint/conflict***
- ***SST: Unforeseen mission requirements should be added as a potential constraint/conflict.***

The next meeting of the E&T JCSG is scheduled for Aug 12th.

- **Potential FT Subgroup scenario: Consolidate Rotary Wing undergraduate flight training sub-functions and consolidate some T-6.**
 - **Losing site(s):**
 - NAS Whiting Field, FL
 - NAS Corpus Christi, TX
 - Vance AFB, OK
 - **Gaining site(s):**
 - Fort Rucker, AL (Rotary Wing)
 - NAS Whiting Field, FL (T-6)
 - **Impact on other facilities/activities**
 - Realign T-6 training from Corpus Christi and Vance to Whiting (Increased NAS Whiting Field FW undergraduate capacity)
 - **Transformational Option(s):**
 - Establish a Single Center of Excellence for Rotary Wing Training [Proposed by E&T JCSG]
 - **Potential constraints or conflicts**
 - Unique Service training cultures
 - Single point of failure

 - **Transformational Option(s)**
 - Maximize Outsourcing of Graduate-Level Education [Proposed by E&T JCSG]
 - **Potential Constraint/Conflicts**
 - Military Specific Graduate Degrees
 - Military Specific Support Spaces (e.g., TS-level spaces)

 - Naval Amphibious Base, Dam Neck, VA [Center for Naval Intelligence]
 - Fleet Intelligence Training Center Pacific San Diego, CA
 - **Gaining site:**
 - Fort Huachuca, AZ
 - **Impact on other facilities/activities**
 - TBD (potential expansion of other activities identified by MilDeps and other JCSGs)
 - **Transformational Option:**
 - Establish Centers of Excellence for Joint or Inter-service education and training by combining or co-locating like schools. [Proposed by E&T JCSG]
 - **Potential constraints or conflicts**
 - Selection Criteria #7 – impact on community’s infrastructure
 - Can’t capture changing mission requirements with current data

- **Potential Ranges Subgroup re-alignment scenario: In support of IGPBS decisions to transfer four maneuver UAs and multiple support UAs**
 - **Losing site(s):**
 - U.S. Army, Europe: Schweinfurt, Baumholder, Friedburg, Vilseck
 - **Gaining site(s):**
 - Fort Bliss, TX (McGregor Range)
 - **Impact on other facilities/activities**
 - Creates expansive ground maneuver live fire complex for Army and USMC units
 - Increases unit availability for early testing of developmental systems
 - Provides expanded Air/Ground Range Capability (Cannon AFB, NM)
 - Provides JFCOM with a potential for a JNTC (Joint National Training Center) site
 - Additional collective/unit training capability at White Sands Missile Range, NM
 - **Transformational Option(s):**
 - Establish regional Cross-Service and Cross-Functional ranges [Proposed by E&T JCSG]
 - **Potential constraints or conflicts**
 - BLM ownership of Fort Bliss (McGregor Range)
 - Cross-Functional Range scheduling and coordination
 - Range infrastructure at Fort Bliss may need to be increased
