EDUCATION AND TRAINING JOINT CROSS-SERVICE GROUP
MEETING MINUTES OF 23 SEPTEMBER 2004

The Assistant Secretary of the Air Force (Manpower and Reserve Affairs), Mr. Dominguez, presided over the 25th meeting of the E&T JCSG as acting chair. Attendee list is at Attachment 1. Mr Dominguez welcomed participants and reminded principals that E&T JCSG meetings are now weekly, but more frequent meetings will probably be needed in order to review and approve scenarios to meet ISG deadlines. Subgroups were also asked to surface to their Service principal staff requirements or shortfalls in a timely manner.

Mr. Howlett provided an overview of the meeting agenda and asked key participants to ensure their calendars are annotated since participation is crucial to the timely review and approval of Subgroup proposals. The first batch of scenarios approved at the 16 September meeting was entered in the OSD tracking tool. The E&T JCSG is scheduled to brief Subgroups philosophy, strategy and scenarios to the ISG on 1 October. Mr. Howlett then reported the status of E&T JCSG Requests for Clarification (RFCs) by Service (and DOD Agencies). Services are working to clarify/correct capacity information for E&T JCSG Subgroups and have made some progress. OSD BRAC is working with the JCSG to identify and correct incidences in which the Services have submitted data to OSD, but process issues have delayed/prohibited getting the information to the JCSG. Finally, Subgroup inputs are due on 24 September for the Capacity Analysis Report. (Attachment 2)

Mr Dominguez updated the group on a 22 September meeting he chaired to discuss E&T JCSG analysis of Professional Continuing Education. Each Service and E&T JCSG Subgroup was represented at the meeting. One hundred nineteen courses across 10 functional areas were identified within this category. The SST and PDE Subgroups already include 47 courses in their analyses. The remaining courses are wide-spread and diverse, with no value added for joint-ness or consolidation. (Attachment 2)

The E&T JCSG agreed to limit E&T JCSG analysis to the 47 courses that could yield potential efficiencies and/or effectiveness.

The remainder of the meeting was devoted to Flight Training (RADM Mayer), PDE (BG Maffey) and SST (Brig Gen Hostage) presentations of scenario development philosophies and strategies (Attachment 2). Ranges Subgroup philosophy had been discussed in a previous meeting.

The next meeting of the E&T JCSG is scheduled for 30 September 2004.
