EDUCATION AND TRAINING JOINT CROSS-SERVICE GROUP
MEETING MINUTES OF OCTOBER 28, 2004

The Assistant Secretary of the Air Force (Manpower and Reserve Affairs), Mr. Dominguez, presided over the 30th meeting of the E&T JCSG as acting chair. Attendee List is at Attachment 1. Mr. Howlett provided a brief overview of the meeting agenda and reminded Principals and Subgroup Chairmen that an extended E&T JCSG meeting is scheduled for November 10, 2004 (0830-1300 in the SecAF Conference Room). Mr. Howlett then reported the status of E&T JCSG Requests for Clarification (RFCs) for Capacity and Military Value Data by Service (and DoD Agencies). Mr. Dominguez again discussed the need to move ahead with scenario development in order to meet the ISG timeline. *He therefore proposed that subgroups lock OSD certified data as of November 2, 2004 and get responses for Requests for Clarification (RFCs) related to unresolved topics directly from the Services. This should expedite the flow of needed data and allow Subgroups to move ahead on scenario development. Subgroups will need to go back to the OSD database eventually and update models with certified data. Principals and Subgroup Chairmen agreed to this proposal.*

Subgroup Chairmen or their representative (RADM George Mayer, Col Jerry Lynes, Col James Briggs, Dr. John Foulkes and Mr. Thomas Macia) briefed Subgroup issues/concerns and/or proposals (Attachment 2). The following is a summary of the discussions:

- To validate their automated optimization tool/model, the Flight Training Subgroup "ran" a test analysis asking the model to consolidate the present fixed-wing Undergraduate Flight Training (UFT) bases using only capacity data (assigned each base the same Military Value). Without Military Value as a discriminator, the Flight Training optimization Model indicates present fixed-wing operations may "fit" on 7 or 8 of the 11 installations presently performing this function today. However, the Subgroup will not be able to propose recommendations for consolidation without "Military Value" scoring still waiting final clarification of some data call information. Further, the optimization model did not apportion functions based on unique mission requirements. Since the model may not have retained the integrity of functions like Undergraduate Navigator / Naval Flight Officer training, these initial results indicating possible closures maybe premature.
- The Flight Training Subgroup is preparing the optimization model to follow their previously briefed business strategy of considering consolidation of the advanced phase UFT programs with follow-on FRS/FTU training prior to assignment to operational squadrons. The Principals discussed the Services opposition to this strategy. *The Subgroup was tasked to consider the points bought out in the discussion and comeback to the E&T JCSG to discuss their business strategy again.*

- The Optimization Models will not be run for Rotary Wing, Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) and Joint Strike Fighter (JSF) single site selection since there are limited sites to be analyzed. Spreadsheets containing Capacity and Military Value information will be used in order to develop proposals for E&T JCSG consideration.
- Professional Development Education briefed three proposals for E&T JCSG consideration and approval and confirmed that a fourth proposal was not recommended for consideration. ***All three were approved as scenarios and entering into the ISG Tracking Tool.*** One of the scenarios had a reverse option available. The reverse option was ruled out because of the comparative military value scores. The scenario proposed and accepted scored approximately 20 points higher than the reverse option. PDE has completed entering proposal for 2 of its 3 functions.
- Specialized Skill Training recommended deletion from the ISG Tracking Tool a scenario that the E&T JCSG approved October 7, 2004. This scenario proposed establishing a Joint Center of Excellence for Space Training at Vandenberg AFB, CA. The original scenario was strategy-based. Subsequently, data call information was received that showed space courses are already consolidated at Vandenberg AFB and there is no further value added in pursuing this scenario. ***The E&T JCSG agreed with the rationale and approved deletion of this scenario in the ISG Tracking Tool.***
- The Ranges Subgroup proposed withdrawing four conceptual Test and Evaluation proposals previously approved by the JCSG. The Subgroup will perform data-driven analysis and provide new proposals by the November 10, 2004 E&T JCSG meeting. Dr. Foulkes suggested a meeting between the E&T JCSG Ranges Subgroup and representatives of the Technical JCSG to discuss proposed and ISG Tracking Tool registered scenarios. Results of this meeting will be briefed to the E&T JCSG. Ranges Subgroup (Training) presented a concept for establishing a joint coordination cell associated with proposals brought forward. ***E&T JCSG approved this conceptually and directed that the Ranges Subgroup coordinate this with JFCOM.***

The next scheduled meeting of the E&T JCSG is Thursday, November 4, 2004.

- Status Quo ... Capacity Model indicates present fixed-wing operations would “fit” on 8 of the 11 installations presently in use**
 - Not able to determine “Best of Breed” without “MilVal” Scoring**
 - Did not “exclude” the Euro-NATO Joint Jet Training (Sheppard AFB) or Pilot Instructor Training (Randolph AFB) from the Query**

- Consolidate “like” UFT Programs**
 - Keep Primary Phase of all Services UFT together ... T-6 Aircraft**
 - Keep all aspects of Nav/NFO Programs together ... EWO,**
 - Keep Advanced Phase of Tanker, Transport, and “TACAMO” together ... T-1**

- Combine Advanced Phase with FRS / FTU**
 - T-38 / T-45 with Joint Strike Fighter FRS / FTU**

Testing and Evaluation



1. **RFCs**: Looking to drive ALL to 0 by 5 November.
2. **Data Driven Scenarios**: In view of the action given last week for the T&E SWG to do a data-driven analysis to compare between each of the 2 sets (FW East vs. West; and Air Armaments East versus West), the T&E SWG would like to withdraw these 4 proposals, allow for the RFC close-out to generate useable data to develop bottom-up data driven proposal(s). Expected by 10 November.
3. **Scenario Data Call**: Questions are being drafted in support of the 2 accepted strategy-driven scenarios, and also in anticipation of the data-driven scenarios. Conditional on the selection of the official scenario data call template, questions will be entered by 10 November.
4. **Integrated test range - training range proposals**: At today's Technical JCSG meeting, Dr. Foulkes suggested to the chair that a "round-table" laydown of all of the registered proposals among the TJCSG and the E&T Ranges Subgroup (both Test and Training) be conducted early next week. Al Shaffer (TJCSG) will coordinate with Bob Howlett (E&T JCSG).






