**EDUCATION AND TRAINING JOINT CROSS-SERVICE GROUP
MEETING MINUTES OF DECEMBER 9, 2004**

The Principal Deputy Under Secretary of Defense (P&R), Mr. Abell, chaired the 35th meeting of the E&T JCSG. Attendee List is at Attachment 1.

Rear Admiral Steve "Smiley" Enewold, Program Executive Officer, F-35 Joint Strike Fighter Program, briefed the integrated training center concept for the Joint Strike Fighter (JSF). (*Briefing requested, 18 Nov.*) Briefing is at Attachment 2. At the conclusion of the presentation, Mr. Abell thanked RADM Enewold for taking the time to brief the principals and answer their questions. After the departure of the presenters, the group reviewed upcoming E&T JCSG activities and scenario data call status. The mandatory language for Criteria Six was also briefly discussed. The mandated language must be reflected in all candidate recommendations and captures economic impact of scenarios in a consistent manner. Details will be provided in training sessions that OSD BRAC will schedule in the near future. The Capacity Analysis Report and the Military Value Reports are over due to the ISG. It was noted that weights of two attributes in the Range Subgroup Military Value Scoring Plans and Military Value Ranking were inconsistent. Due to a typographical error, the values of Synergy and Encroachment attributes were transposed in the July 2004 Report. The correct values were used in the military value analysis. This administrative error will be corrected in the latest edition of the Military Value Analysis Report.

Mr. Abell thanked the Army principal for moving out aggressively to ensure E&T JCSG subgroup participants received COBRA training in a timely manner. Sixteen members were trained by the Army COBRA POC on December 7, 2004.

Subgroup Chairmen and/or their representatives (RADM George Mayer, Brig Gen Hostage and BG Tom Maffey, Mr. Tom Macia) briefed their Subgroup status (Attachment 3). The following is a summary of the discussions:

- The Flight Training Subgroup briefed a "best case" timeline for providing candidate recommendations for E&T JCSG approval. Anticipated dates will probably slip based on timeliness and quality of data received from the MilDeps as well as the time required for subsequent analyses for criteria 6-8 on those scenarios approved for continuation by the JCSG. The Chairman mentioned to the group that he would like a standard timeline slide to show the ISG, like the slide briefed by the subgroups. The key is to show status by scenario and that the formats were standardized. The subgroup then informed the group that the recently enacted Congressional Defense Authorization Bill tasked SECDEF to

submit to the congressional defense committees NLT January 28, 2005 a report on the need for one of more national centers of excellence for Unmanned Aerial and Ground Vehicles (UAV/UGV). Services are working with the UAV Planning Task Force (OUSD (AT&L)/DS-AW) independent of BRAC to respond to a Congressional language. Results from these two UAV/UGV evaluations may vary. OSD BRAC is aware of parallel initiatives and no action is required at this time.

The group discussed briefly that E&T JCSG declared scenarios (E&T 0047 & 0048) realign advanced phases of undergraduate pilot training (e.g., T-1) at graduate-level (and operational) flight training bases (e.g., C-130) and could potentially conflict with Service doctrine.

- ▶ ***E&T JCSG agreed to receive a briefing from the Air Force on the operational and doctrinal challenges posed by these concepts as part of the scenario analysis process at the December 16 meeting.***
- Specialized Skill Training Subgroup briefed their estimated timeline for providing candidate recommendations for E&T JCSG approval. It is also noted that these dates could slip into February 2005 based on timeliness and quality of data received from the MilDeps. The Subgroup has already experienced an intensive work effort resolving data issues with the Military Departments (Mil Deps). Mr. Brian Buzzell, OSD BRAC Office, stressed the requirement for all subgroups to work aggressively with the Mil Deps to resolve incorrect or missing data. Issues that can not be resolved (at the O6 or equivalent-level) should be surfaced to the JCSG as soon as possible. The group then briefly discussed the Maintenance Training Center concept with the Joint Strike Fighter (JSF). ***The Subgroup was tasked to build a series of proposals for the 16 Dec 04 meeting to compliment the Flight Training Subgroups Integrated Training Concept.*** The Subgroup had one proposal to present for E&T JCSG consideration. The E&T JCSG:
 - ▶ ***Approved proposal to “establish Joint Center of Consolidated Transportation Management Training (Fort Lee, VA)”***
- Professional Development Education Subgroup briefed the timeline for candidate recommendations should be sometime the end of January 2005. This date is based on “best case” circumstances and could slip into February, if information from MilDeps is delayed or incorrect. The group discussed an Army proposal to realign the Army War College and the Army Command and Staff College to Fort Leavenworth, KS. This proposal had been considered and rejected at the 14 October E&T JCSG meeting. Based on subsequent analysis from the Army, the PDE subgroup will bring this proposal to the E&T JCSG on 16 Dec for reconsideration.
- Ranges Subgroup briefed the “best case” timeline for providing candidate recommendations for E&T JCSG approval. Like the other subgroups, these days

received from the Mil Deps. The Navy principal surfaced a concern that an audit might be needed to ascertain the accuracy of range data from the Mil Deps. The DoD IG has completed an audit on the training range data and should have the T&E range audit completed in the near future. The E&T JCSG will be briefed on results to include any problem areas or concerns with data provided by the Services.

The next scheduled meeting of the E&T JCSG is Thursday, December 16, 2004.

 - *“Economic Impact on Communities: Assuming no economic recovery, this recommendation could result in a maximum potential reduction of XXX jobs (YYY direct jobs and ZZZ indirect jobs) over the 2006-2011 period in the [fill in name of the metropolitan statistical area, metropolitan division, metropolitan statistical area or county] economic area, which is x.x percent of economic area employment.”*

Congressional Defense Authorization Bill: UAV TASKING

- **Language in the Congressional Defense Authorization Bill: “Not later than 120 days after the date of the enactment of this act, the SECDEF shall submit to the congressional defense committees a report on the need for one or more national centers of excellence for Unmanned Aerial and Ground Vehicles (UAV/UGV).”**
 - Enacted 10/28/04: Suspense: 01/28/05
 - Services are working with OSD - independent of BRAC
 - Allows for multiple centers
 - Includes UAV & UGV
 - Focuses on RDT&E
- **OSD BRAC is aware of parallel initiatives**
- **E&T JCSG FLT TRNG: Tasked to formulate a UAV training COE**
- **Issue: Results from the two evaluations may vary**
- **ACTION: No Action Required (FYI Only)**
