

BRAC 2005**EDUCATION AND TRAINING JOINT CROSS-SERVICE GROUP****MEETING MINUTES of APRIL 14, 2005**

The Principal Deputy Under Secretary of Defense (P&R), Mr. Charles Abell, chaired the 51st meeting of the E&T JCSG. A list of attendees is at Attachment 1. Currently, the E&T JCSG has 10 active candidate recommendations (17 forwarded for ISG/IEC review; 3 disapproved and 4 integrated into Military Department candidate recommendations). The Chairman thanked everyone for their hard work over the past two years. The E&T JCSG Coordination Team announced plans to forward recognition guidance, to include joint awards for military and civilian personnel, to the Chair for review and approval. Subgroups were encouraged to review manpower history to ensure all deserving personnel are identified and considered for appropriate recognition. Participants were updated on future administrative/report/briefing/testimony requirements. Mr. Abell encouraged subgroups again to stay focused as we enter this phase of the BRAC process and to ensure subgroups retain personnel with the expertise necessary to respond to future requirements (Attachment 2). The Army alternate principal reminded the group of the need to prepare scenario E&T – 10 Urban Operations to complete for closed bases/installations once BRAC is signed into law. (Scenario E&T - 10 was deleted in concept as a non-BRAC but BRAC-related issue at the 15, March ISG Meeting.)

Flight Training Subgroup briefed E&T 0046R – Cooperative, which the IEC directed at the 4 April 2005 meeting. This revised candidate recommendation removes Introduction to Fighter Fundamentals and Undergraduate Pilot Training (UPT) and T-6 training (all assets realigned within other current USAF UPT bases) from Moody AFB, GA, and realigns Undergraduate Navigator Training (UNT) from Randolph AFB, TX to NAS Pensacola, FL. The Flight Training Subgroup presented detailed differences between E&T 0046 and E&T 0046R. In an effort to ensure an “apples to apples” comparison of these alternative scenarios, the output from E&T 0046 was rerun and presented side-by-side with E&T 0046R, using the same personnel savings (the elimination of government employed maintenance personnel at Moody AFB and their realignment into contractor maintenance personnel at all other undergraduate pilot training bases) applied to E&T 0046R. All data was coordinated with USAF-BRAC.



Documentation -- Legislation

- (2) The Secretary shall include, with the list of recommendations published and transmitted pursuant to paragraph (1), **a summary of the selection process** that resulted in the recommendation for each installation, including a justification for each recommendation.
- (4) In addition to making **all information used by the Secretary to prepare the recommendations** under this subsection available to Congress (including any committee or member of Congress), the Secretary shall also make such information available to the Commission and the Comptroller General of the United States.
- **Any information provided to the Commission** by a person described in paragraph (5)(B) **shall also be submitted to the Senate and the House** of Representatives to be made available to the Members of the House concerned in accordance with the rules of that House. The information shall be submitted to the Senate and House of Representatives **within 48 hours** after the submission of the information to the Commission.
