





Joint Use of Resources


- Special Operations elements (SOCOM) use the training facilities and ranges

Campbell Army Airfield

- Aircraft flight maneuvers
 - C130 Drop Zone
 - Instrumented Arrival and Departure Training
 - 275,000 air movements/year

- Largest Army heliport
- Three battalions of UH-60 helicopters assigned to Sabre Army Airfield
- Parking and tie-down points for more than 90 helicopters
- 100,000 Air movements/yr
- Runway capable of supporting C17 deployments
- Primary Night Vision Device Training Airfield





Golden Eagle Flight Landing Strip

Radar Approach Control Area/ Populated Area



CAAF Avigational Easements

- Intended to control development and preserve height clearances within aircraft approach of CAAF main runway
- Offer letters are now being sent to property owners
- Acquisition expected to be completed by May 2004

Easement Types

- 1) *Clear Zone** – height/use restrictions
- 2) *APZ I* – height/use restrictions
- 3) *APZ II* – height restrictions
- 4) *Approach Departure Surface Zone* – height restrictions



Environmental Considerations

- Inside the Fence (Internal)
 - Two Federally Listed Species
 - 4,000 Acres Unique Grasslands
 - No Training Restrictions due to Threatened and Endangered Species*
- Outside the Fence (External)
 - 100-200 Noise Complaints Annually
 - Proactive Installation-Community Programs to Prevent Incompatible Use
 - Minimal Training Restrictions due to Urban Encroachment*






