Dear Lesia:

I wanted to thank you again for meeting with Ed Edens and me on Tuesday to discuss the AFIP radiology-pathology registry and training program.

In response to the questions you raised, approximately 1,200 radiology residents are trained in the AFIP program annually, including 47 military residents. The program is housed on the main campus of Walter Reed. The physical archive of the repository is housed in a room that is approximately 1220 square feet. There are two servers that house the more recent (since 1997) additions to the archive, which is all digital information.

The personnel requirement for managing the physical archive is currently 1.2 FTE's. There is also a computer system administrator that spends about 50% of his time managing the electronic database.
