Dear General Jumper:

I invite you to appear before the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Commission on August 11, 2005 to hear your constructive comments regarding the 2005 BRAC Air National Guard recommendations. It is incumbent upon this Commission to ensure that the Department of Defense's closure and realignment recommendations, especially those pertaining to the Air National Guard, do not undermine the unique mission responsibilities of the Department of Homeland Security. The Commission strongly believes that our nation's senior civilian and military leadership will not be able to develop a responsible solution to the issues surrounding the Air Guard without significant input from the Air Force. In this regard, we anticipate holding two separate panels. The first panel will be comprised of the Office of the Secretary of Defense, the Department of Homeland Security, and U.S. Northern Command. The second panel will be comprised of you or your representative, the National Guard Bureau, and a representative from the Adjutants General Association of the United States.

The Commission would appreciate receiving confirmation of your attendance, as well as a copy of your unclassified statement for the record, in hard copy and electronic format (CD), by noon on Friday, August 5, 2005.
