Synopsis of Discussion Items:

Review 5 May 2004 Minutes

- JAST concurred with 5 May 2004 Minutes as written.

Review Services' MVA Attributes (Questions)

- Understanding. The Services are currently reviewing the sister Services' MVA questions for clarity and understanding, so the answering Services can provide adequate responses.
- Commonality. The JAST reviewed the MILDEPs' MV questions to determine if there was significant commonality between the MILDEPs. Out of the approximately 226 questions (all MILDEPs), only five questions were deemed as common (air ops between AF & Navy). Therefore, the JAST was in agreement to proceed as previously agreed -- send all MVA questions to the list of potential installations.

Joint Action Scenario Development Process Plan

- USAF representative informed JAST that Air Force now concurs with Joint Action Scenario Development Plan.

Outstanding Issues – Rollup

- JAST representatives were asked to continue working through the outstanding issues, since the issues will be reviewed at the next JAST meeting. Issue #8, MVA questions for Data Call #2, remains high priority. JAST members agreed to expedite the review so questions can be included in the upcoming Data Call.

Other Comments

- USAF representative indicated that it is doubtful the Air Force would consider moving forces onto an Army or Navy installation.

Decisions:

1. JAST agreed that all MVA questions should be sent to the list of potential installations, and would make that recommendation to their BRAC Directors.

Recommendations:

- JAST members update their BRAC Directors on lack of commonality of MILDEP MVA questions and all MVA questions be sent to potential installations.
- Services expeditiously review sister Services' MVA questions for clarity and understanding, so the answering Services can provide adequate responses.
- BRAC Directors approve Joint Action Scenario Development Plan.
