### Synopsis of Discussion Items:

#### Review 3 January 2005 Minutes

- The JAST reviewed and approved the 3 January 2005 Minutes.

#### New Ideas

- No new JAST scenario ideas were presented.

#### Status update of current ideas

- The JAST members reviewed all scenario ideas, provided status updates, and reconciled their records.

### Review and update MILDEPs' OSD numbers

- The JAST members reviewed all scenario idea numbers and their MILDEPs' corresponding ISG Scenario Tracking Tool numbers where applicable.
  - Army to determine status of participation; then provide appropriate OSD# for HSA001 if applicable.
  - Navy to provide appropriate OSD# for JAST A034, N001, N016, N017, N018, and MC005.
  - USAF to provide appropriate OSD# for N018 and HSA001.

### JAST documentation and reporting

- The JAST members discussed methods on how to document and record the results of all JAST scenario ideas. All agreed that the JAST will establish and maintain a record of each potential scenario. Since the JAST works within existing MILDEP BRAC structures, the members agreed the JAST Scenario Idea Summary sheets should be revised and streamlined, and refer to the applicable MILDEP(s)' OSD#. The Army representative will review the current format, make appropriate revisions, and provide recommendations to the JAST at a future meeting.

### Other Issues

- The JAST recommended the Army assume the other services' deliberative bodies support their portions of the joint actions and advise the other services of its intent to submit its Candidate Recommendations.

### **Decisions:**

- The JAST members continue to review their MILDEPs' OSD# in the ISG Tracking Tool and provide updates to their counterparts.
- The Army representative will review the current JAST Scenario Idea Summary form, revise the format, and provide recommendations to the JAST.

### **Recommendations;**

1. The JAST members provide feedback to their BRAC Directors and update at the next JAST meeting.
2. Due to the federal holiday and competing BRAC priorities, the JAST is not scheduled to meet formally during the week of 17 January. However, JAST issues will continue to be worked off-line as required.
3. New JAST scheduled to meet on 24 January 2004.
