Review 26 October 2004 Minutes

- JAST approved the 26 October 2004 Minutes.

Review JAST Scenario Ideas

- New Ideas.
 - The Army submitted one (1) new joint operational basing scenario idea (JAST#A085). The JAST learned that the Technical JCSG is considering a similar scenario. Therefore, the Army will clarify the scenario idea and provide an update to the JAST.
- Status of Current Ideas.
 - The Navy JAST representative reported that after further review, the Navy BRAC Director recommends “further study” on JAST Scenario Idea #A030, a previously closed scenario idea. Therefore, the JAST reopened A030 for further study by the Army and Navy.

- The Air Force JAST representative will confirm the Air Force BRAC Director's decision on for "further study" or "no further study" on A079, A080, A081, and A084. The Army JAST representative will review and clarify the major units and installations cited in those scenario ideas and provide clarification to the Air Force and other JAST members.
- The Army JAST representative provided electronic copies of all JAST scenario ideas (A001-A085), as of 1 November, to the JAST members.
- Feedback on review of ISG Tracker input
 - Army: Army BRAC office has scrubbed its input to the ISG Tracker and has not found any other scenarios that require JAST review.
 - Navy: Navy JAST representative reported the Navy BRAC office is continuing its review and will provide feedback to the JAST.
 - Air Force: Air Force JAST representative reported that the Air Force has not made any inputs to the ISG Tracker which require JAST review.
- Discuss Scenario Idea Analysis Process.
 - The JAST reconfirmed the principal of working within the existing MILDEP BRAC structures. Once the MILDEPs' deliberative bodies have declared proposals for formal analysis, the MILDEP will enter the scenario idea into the ISG Tracker. The JAST members again reiterated the importance of the MILDEP BRAC offices openly sharing information, coordinating their scenario descriptions, closely coordinating their analyses, and continually synchronizing their efforts.

Decisions:

- The JAST changed the status of #A030 status to OPEN with "further study".

Recommendations:

1. JAST members continue to follow up with their MILDEP BRAC POCs to ensure they are closely coordinating joint scenario ideas and synchronizing their actions with the appropriate Service counterparts.
2. JAST members continue to meet and provide updates. The next meeting is scheduled for 8 November 2004.
