Synopsis of Discussion Items:

Review 18 August 2004 Minutes

- JAST concurred with 18 August 2004 Minutes as written.

Review JAST Scenario Ideas

- The purpose of the JAST meeting was to review scenario ideas the Army submitted and determine the Lead Service and Supporting Services(s) with Points of Contact who will conduct the analysis.
- JAST received and reviewed thirty-six (36) scenario ideas.
 - Army RC-PAT representative presented thirty-three (33) scenario ideas generated by Reserve Components.
 - Army to lead sixteen (15). *One idea did not appear to involve another MILDEP; therefore, the suggestion was made for the Army to reconsider and coordinate within the Army and appropriate JCSG..*
 - Navy to lead five (5).
 - Air Force to lead eleven (12).

- One (1) idea requires further clarification before assignment can be made.
- Army JAST representative presented three (3) other scenario ideas which appear to have merit and should also be brought to the attention of the BRAC Directors.
- Army Proposal Information Management System (PIMS) will reflect status of all Army generated scenario ideas, e.g., those referred to the JAST will reflect JAST Scenario# and status updates within PIMS.

Outstanding Issues

- None.

Next Steps

- Schedule follow-up JAST meetings to better support the BRAC Directors' meetings and BRAC review process.

Decisions:

1. JAST members will inform their BRAC Directors of the scenario ideas presented and provide feedback from their BRAC Directors at the next JAST meeting.
2. Lead Service POCs will establish coordination with Supporting Service POC.
3. JAST will meet during the week of 27 September 2004 to review remaining RC scenario ideas as well as other MILDEP joint basing scenario ideas.

Recommendations:

1. BRAC Directors review the joint scenario ideas presented to the JAST and direct "further study" or "no further study" and inform their JAST members of their decision.
2. Each Service record and maintain the current status in its Proposal Information Management System of all JAST scenario ideas for which it is the lead Service.
3. JAST schedule future meetings in coordination and synchronization with the "*BRAC Battle Rhythm*" review process.
