Synopsis of Discussion Items:

Review 10 January 2005 Minutes

- The JAST reviewed and approved the 10 January 2005 Minutes.

New Ideas

- The Army presented two (2) new JAST scenario ideas: A086 and A087. Both scenario ideas involve Army/USAF. The JAST believes both scenario ideas warrant further study and assigned Army and USAF Points of Contact. The Army intends to submit both as Candidate Recommendations in the immediate future. Therefore, the Army representative requested that the JAST members update their BRAC Directors within the next 2 to 3 days of the Army's intent.

Status update of current ideas

- The JAST members reviewed all scenario ideas, provided status updates, and reconciled their records. The JAST reported the following updates:

- A006, A026, A043, A052, and A055 – USAF reported inadequate contiguous space. Therefore, these scenario ideas were “closed” in JAST and referred back to the Army for action.
- A012 and A028 – The Army representative provided the revised Short Titles for both scenario ideas. The revised titles now more accurately reflect the scenario ideas.
- HSA001 – The Army representative confirmed that the Army does not intend to participate in this scenario idea. Therefore, HSA001 was “closed” in JAST and referred to the USAF for action.
- HSA002 – The Army, Navy, and OSD representatives confirmed that since proposed move is from one AFB to another AFB, the scenario idea has been referred to USAF for action. Therefore, HSA002 was “closed” in JAST and referred to the USAF for action.

JAST documentation and reporting

- The JAST members tabled the discussion on the methods documenting and recording the results of all JAST scenario ideas. The JAST agreed to review the current JAST Scenario Idea Summary format and discuss revisions and recommendations at a future meeting.

Other Issues

- The Army representative provided the JAST a summary of the 19 Jan 05 JAST Update to the BRAC Directors.

Decisions:

- The Army representative will continue to review the current JAST Scenario Idea Summary form, revise the format, and provide recommendations to the JAST.

Recommendations;

1. The JAST members provide feedback to their BRAC Directors on the two new scenario ideas: A086 and A087.
2. New JAST scheduled to meet on 31 January 2005.
