Synopsis of Discussion Items:

Review 7 February 2005 Minutes

- The JAST reviewed and approved the 7 February 2005 Minutes.

New Ideas.

- The JAST reviewed one new scenario idea, **N019**. The Navy had previously furnished scenario idea N019 to the USAF for coordination and to the Army for information.

Status update of current ideas

- The Army representative provided a copy of the current status of all scenario ideas.
- The JAST members reviewed all scenario ideas, provided status updates, and reconciled their records.
- The JAST highlighted the importance of updating the status of the scenario idea and requested status changes/updates be provided to the Army representative immediately.
- The Army representative expressed concern that numerous RC JAST scenario ideas reflect Navy participation (with DON OSD numbers). However, the Army has not received definitive communication to determine which RC JAST scenario ideas will become joint basing Candidate Recommendations and which will become Army stand alone recommendations.

JAST documentation and reporting

- All JAST scenario ideas have now been recorded on the revised Scenario Ideas Summary form (7 Feb 05). Copies of all 113 scenario ideas were provided to the JAST attendees for review and update.
- Joint Cross Service Group (JCSG) referrals. The JAST emphasized that the Services are responsible to refer to the appropriate JCSG those scenario ideas the JAST has agreed should be pursued by the JCSG vs. by the MILDEPs.

Recommendations:

1. Reviews and updates. Recommend JAST members review all scenario ideas and provide updates to their appropriate JAST counterparts in the other Services and the Army representative.
2. JCSG referrals. Recommend each Service ensure that its ideas requiring JCSG action have been referred to the applicable JCSG.
3. Recommend the Navy provide its “go/no-go” decisions to the Army so the Army can finalize its joint basing Candidate Recommendations.
4. Recommend the JAST next meet on 7 March 2005.
