Synopsis of Discussion Items:

Review 30 September 2004 Minutes

- JAST concurred with 30 September 2004 Minutes as written.

Review JAST Scenario Ideas

- Feedback from BRAC Directors. MILDEP JAST representatives are continuing to review JAST scenario ideas and coordinate with their BRAC Directors. They will provide feedback at the next JAST meeting scheduled for 12 October 2004.
- Review Proposal Ideas.
 - The Army submitted eleven (11) new RC scenario ideas (JAST #A068 – #A078). The JAST reviewed the scenario ideas and assigned the Lead Service and Supporting Services with Points of Contact.

Issues

- Scenario Analysis Process
 - The JAST continued discussion on how the MILDEPS should conduct the analyses once the BRAC Directors approve the scenario ideas for further study. The JAST will discuss the process in more detail at the next JAST meeting, and then provide a recommendation to the MILDEP BRAC Directors.

Next Steps

- The JAST is scheduled to meet during the week of 12 October to follow up on current scenario ideas, review new scenario ideas, and discuss scenario analysis process.

Decisions:

1. The JAST members will continue to review, coordinate, monitor progress, and assist information flow on joint scenario ideas, and provide feedback from their BRAC Directors.
2. The JAST will meet during the week of 12 October 2004.

Recommendations:

1. BRAC Directors review the joint scenario ideas presented to the JAST and direct “further study” or “no further study” and inform their JAST members of their decision.
2. JAST flesh out process methodology details at next JAST meeting.
