Synopsis of Discussion Items:

Review 28 February 2005 Minutes

- The JAST reviewed and approved the 28 February 2005 Minutes.

New Ideas.

- The JAST reviewed one new scenario idea, **N020**. The Navy had previously furnished (faxed copy) N020 to the USAF for coordination and to the Army for information on 4 Mar 05. The Army RC and Navy JAST representatives agreed to review this scenario idea and determine if it can be consolidated with JAST **A011**.

Status update of current ideas

- Based on previous input from and coordination with the Navy representative, numerous RC JAST scenario ideas no longer have joint MILDEP participation. Therefore, those ideas were closed in JAST and referred back to the Army for action.
- The Army representative expressed concern with the following five (5) scenario ideas that have been closed, and informed the Navy representative that the Army BRAC Director will raise those concerns with the Navy BRAC Director: **A014, A019, A022, A029, & A040**.
- The JAST conducted a line-by-line status reconciliation of all scenario ideas.

Other issues

- Joint Cross Service Group (JCSG) referrals. The JAST once again reminded the JAST members that the respective Services are responsible for referring to the appropriate JCSG those scenario ideas the JAST has agreed should be pursued by the JCSG.
- JAST was cautioned to follow the Internal Control Plan and not transmit scenario specific information via email.

Next steps

- JAST scenario ideas need to be finalized and submitted as Candidate Recommendations.
- Schedule status update briefing for BRAC Directors.

Recommendations:

1. Reviews and updates. Recommend JAST members review all scenario ideas and provide updates to their appropriate JAST counterparts in the other Services and the Army representative.
2. Review of **N020**. Army and Navy JAST representatives review N020 to determine whether it should be consolidated with JAST **A011**.
3. Army and Navy BRAC Directors discuss impact of Navy non support of **A014, A019, A022, A029, & A040** and determine appropriate way ahead.
4. Recommend the JAST next meet on 14 March 2005.
