DON 0138	<b>Short Description:</b> <sup>4</sup> Naval Air Station Brunswick closes, necessitating realignment of air assets to Naval Air Station Jacksonville. In addition Naval Mobile Construction Battalion (NMCB) 27 is realigned to Westover ARB, MA. It consists of 5 active duty enlisted and 300 drilling reservists, and 16 SeaBee vehicles. 18,000 SY of pavement and 24,000 square feet of buildings are required. Move to occur in 2007. 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- <sup>1</sup> Date originator generates scenario idea. The three primary sources for scenario ideas are OSD, JAST, and MILDEP BRAC offices. While there are numerous sources of good ideas, the MILDEPs will likely generate the majority of joint operational basing ideas.
- <sup>2</sup> Alphanumeric number identifying the originating Service and portraying the JAST sequence number. A=Army; N=Navy; AF=Air Force; MC=Marine Corps; HSA=HQ & Support Activities; O=OSD.
- <sup>3</sup> Succinct title given by originator.
- <sup>4</sup> Succinct description of scenario idea, given by originator, which describes the “What” and “Why” of the scenario idea.
- <sup>5</sup> Service and name, rank, and phone number of the POC generating the scenario idea.
- <sup>6</sup> Date the scenario is presented to the JAST. Once the MILDEP has generated a joint operational basing scenario, it will present the scenario to the JAST.
- <sup>7</sup> The JAST will receive, review, and bin the idea as “recommend for further study and analysis” or “recommend against further study” for BRAC Directors’ action.
- <sup>8</sup> Comments from JAST reviews. If the BRAC Directors direct further study of an idea, the JAST will coordinate with the applicable MILDEPs to work and develop the scenario. If the BRAC Directors determine an idea does not warrant further study or direct dropping a scenario for any reason, the JAST will terminate the effort, refer the scenario back to the MILDEP and document the BRAC Directors’ decision.
- <sup>9</sup> Date the BRAC Directors initially reviewed the scenario idea or provided feedback on the scenario idea.
- <sup>10</sup> Recommendation from BRAC Directors for further study or no further study.
- <sup>11</sup> Name, rank, and phone number of the Services’ POCs.
- <sup>12</sup> Comments pertaining to Services’ review.
- <sup>13</sup> Date BRAC Directors review of results.
- <sup>14</sup> Comments pertaining to JAST scenario idea: clarification, disposition, OSD Tracking Number(s), and other pertinent information.
