Purpose:

Joint Action Scenario Team (JAST) presentation to the BRAC Directors, or their deputies to:

- Report out JAST Results
- Gain BRAC Directors' Approval

Discussion:

Army JAST representative presented a briefing to the BRAC Directors on the current status and results of all JAST scenario ideas. (Copy of presentation is attached.)

The presentation included the background of the JAST: the BRAC Directors approved the charter in February 2004 and the process plan in June 2004; the JAST has met more than 30 times and has updated the BRAC Directors at least five times; the JAST served as DoD's clearing house for processing joint-basing scenarios and worked within existing MILDEP BRAC structures. The JAST attributed its success to close coordination, sharing essential information, and working jointly to develop scenario options.

The JAST received, reviewed, and processed a total of 114 scenario ideas as shown below:

- Army – 87
 - Army RC (74)
 - Army AC (13)
- Navy – 25
 - USN (20)
 - USMC (5)
- HSA JCSG – 2

Decisions:

- The BRAC Directors approved the JAST scenario ideas with the exception of **N019**.
- Navy informed BRAC Directors that Navy had reopened **N019**.
 - BRAC Directors requested the JAST to review **N019** at the next JAST meeting (4 April 05) and provide results to BRAC Directors.

- Air Force commented that space may be available at the USAF installation in the vicinity of location described in **A015**.
 - BRAC Directors tasked Army and USAF analysts to reexamine **A015** to determine availability and suitability of space.
- Army recommended revising briefing slide #7, to more clearly portray the effects of other MILDEP's decision to not participate in JAST# **A005, A008, A033, A041, A050, A057, A072, A073, and A074**. Briefing slide #7 (see enclosure) has been revised accordingly.
