MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Scenarios HSA-0119 (Atlanta) and HSA-0127 (Guam)

1. This memorandum provides background on how and why scenarios HSA-0119 and HSA-0127 came under HSA JCSG's purview. HSA-0119 recommends the consolidation of Dobbins ARB and NAS Atlanta. Originally, the Navy BRAC Office had developed a Navy scenario in which NAS Atlanta would close and most of the Navy assets on NAS Atlanta would move to Dobbins ARB. In Nov 2004, the Navy BRAC office requested HSA JCSG give consideration to consolidating Atlanta and Dobbins into a "joint" installation. Because both are reserve installations, they did not meet the criteria for being considered a Geographic Cluster. At the Nov 23, 2004 HSA JCSG meeting, the members decided the HSA Installation Management team would analyze the possibilities of a scenario involving the consolidation of Dobbins and Atlanta and develop a formal recommendation if the analysis proved such a consolidation was viable. This resulted in HSA-0119.

Deleted:

2. In a 28 Dec 04 memo, the Special Assistant to the Secretary of the Navy for BRAC requested the HSA JCSG consider adding the installations on Guam for installation consolidation. At the 5 Jan 2005 HSA JCSG meeting, the membership decided to accept the Navy's request and analysis a possible scenario involving the installations on Guam. This resulted in HSA-0127.
