**MEETING SUMMARY:**

The Ingleside/Corpus Christi representatives of the South Texas Military Task Force (STMFTF) provided a comprehensive brief of all the military facilities in the Corpus Christi area and pointed out several areas where they felt that the Department of Defense erred in assessing the Military Value as well as the Strategic Value of the Corpus Christi/Ingleside complex to the national defense.

Those issues were noted, and the BRAC Commission staff will seek to clarify the Department's response during the next few weeks of analysis and during the pending base visits 5 through 8 July.
