Subj: APPOINTMENT OF DON ANALYSIS GROUP MEMBERS

1. On 14 July 2004, the Secretary of the Navy (SECNAV) issued a memo appointing me as the Special Assistant to the Secretary of the Navy for all matters associated with the 2005 Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC). This memo also established a new deliberative body within the DON BRAC Structure called the DON Analysis Group (DAG). The DAG is a subordinate group to the Infrastructure Evaluation Group (IEG) and will be responsible for analyzing DON unique functions. The memo appointed me as Chair of the DAG.




