1. Mr. Wayne Army, Acting ASN (I&E) met with 6 members of the subject group in Room 4D583 at 1000 on 14 Sep 2004. The list of attendees is contained in enclosure (1). CDR David Seinicki CEC, USN, Commander Margaret Carlson, JAGC, USN, of DASN (IS&A) Chris Payne of Congressman Jack Kingston's office, and CDR Bob Reuning CEC, USN of ASN(FM&C) were also present.

2. The members discussed joint basing and their community's ability to accept a Navy mission should it come to middle Georgia. They highlighted their close relationship with the Air Force and the fact that they had no encroachment issues.

When asked how DoD uses the savings from BRAC, Mr. Army highlighted that the Navy has learned a lot in the prior rounds of BRAC implementation and will use those lessons learned for any BRAC 2005 recommendations' implementation. He noted that future implementation would include public sale of land.
