RMKS/1. CONGRESS AUTHORIZED A BASE REALIGNMENT AND CLOSURE ROUND IN 2005. SECDEF HAS DETERMINED THAT BRAC 2005 SHOULD BE THE MEANS BY WHICH WE RECONFIGURE OUR CURRENT INFRASTRUCTURE INTO ONE IN WHICH OPERATIONAL CAPACITY MAXIMIZES BOTH WARFIGHTING CAPABILITY AND EFFICIENCY. OVERARCHING SECDEF GOALS INCLUDE ELIMINATING EXCESS PHYSICAL CAPACITY AND IMPLEMENTING OPPORTUNITIES FOR GREATER JOINT EFFICIENCY. BRAC WILL ENABLE THE U.S. MILITARY TO MATCH FACILITIES TO FORCES, MEET THE THREATS AND CHALLENGES OF A NEW CENTURY, AND MAKE THE WISEST USE OF LIMITED DEFENSE DOLLARS.

2. TO SUPPORT THESE GOALS, THE NAVY SECRETARIAT (DASN((IS&A)) HAS BEEN WORKING CLOSELY WITH OSD AND OTHER SERVICES TO PREPARE DATA CALLS. SEVERAL DATA CALLS ARE EXPECTED TO BE DELIVERED DURING THE COURSE OF THE ANALYTICAL PROCESS. THE FIRST CAPACITY DATA CALL WILL BE RELEASED IN EARLY JAN 04. THIS CAPACITY DATA CALL WILL ENCOMPASS OVER 700 DETAILED QUESTIONS AND REQUIRE A SIGNIFICANT INVESTMENT OF TIME AT THE OVER 700 NAVY ACTIVITIES THAT HAVE BEEN ASSIGNED TO RESPOND TO THIS EFFORT. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT CLEAR, OBJECTIVE AND UNAMBIGUOUS INFORMATION IS RECEIVED FROM THIS AND ALL OTHER DATA CALLS.

3. AN INFRASTRUCTURE ANALYSIS TEAM HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED UNDER DASN (IS&A) TO SUPPORT THE BRAC PROCESS AND ASSIST ACTIVITIES DURING THE DATA CALL PROCESS. A HELP DESK WILL BE ESTABLISHED TO ASSIST ACTIVITIES IN CLARIFYING DATA CALL ISSUES. DUE TO THE SIZE OF THIS FIRST DATA CALL, I SUGGEST ACTIVITIES TAKE THE TIME TO READ IT THROUGH BEFORE ATTEMPTING TO LOAD DATA AND TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE HELP DESK TO CLARIFY ISSUES. SPECIFIC RESPONSE TIMELINES AND HELP DESK INFORMATION WILL BE PROMULGATED AT THE RELEASE OF THE CAPACITY DATA CALL.

4. A THOROUGH COORDINATION EFFORT BETWEEN VARIOUS ORGANIZATIONS

IS ESSENTIAL. BRAC REPORTING ACTIVITIES ARE EXPECTED TO JOINTLY COORDINATE WITH THEIR MISSION CLAIMANTS, HOST INSTALLATIONS AND REGIONAL COMMANDERS PRIOR TO THEIR SUBMISSION TO AVOID, OR AT LEAST SIGNIFICANTLY MINIMIZE CORRECTIONS, AMPLIFICATIONS OR CHANGES TO THE ROUTED DATA CALLS. ADDITIONAL COORDINATION WITH ECHELON III COMMANDS IS ALSO ENCOURAGED. COORDINATION, HOWEVER, MUST BE SAFEGUARDED AS RELEASE OF BRAC DATA/PROCESS INFORMATION TO THOSE WHO HAVE NOT SIGNED NON-DISCLOSURE STATEMENTS IS NOT AUTHORIZED. PLEASE BE SENSITIVE TO THE USE OF UNCLASSIFIED E-MAIL TO EXCHANGE BRAC RELATED INFORMATION. IT SHOULD BE AVOIDED IF POSSIBLE. ADDITIONALLY, AN ACTIVE DIALOG BETWEEN THE NAVY SECRETARIAT, OPNAV N4 AND ECHELON II COMMANDS WILL BE NECESSARY TO SYNCHRONIZE THE REPORTING, REVIEW AND ANALYSIS OF THE BRAC PROCESS. FURTHER INFORMATION ABOUT THIS EFFORT WILL BE FORTHCOMING.

5. THE BRAC DATA CALL PROCESS REQUIRES CERTIFICATION AT ALL LEVELS OF REVIEW AND IS COMPLETED WHEN THE CERTIFYING OFFICIAL SIGNS THE FOLLOWING CERTIFICATION "I CERTIFY THAT THE INFORMATION CONTAINED HEREIN IS ACCURATE AND COMPLETE TO THE BEST OF MY KNOWLEDGE AND BELIEF." THE SIGNING OF SUCH A CERTIFICATION SHALL CONSTITUTE A REPRESENTATION THAT THE CERTIFYING OFFICIAL HAS REVIEWED THE

INFORMATION AND EITHER (1) PERSONALLY VOUCHES FOR ITS ACCURACY AND COMPLETENESS OR (2) HAS POSSESSION OF, AND IS RELYING UPON, A CERTIFICATION EXECUTED BY A COMPETENT SUBORDINATE. THIS COLLABORATION WILL BE ACTIVELY MONITORED BY NAVAUDSVC DURING THE DATA CALL PROCESS.

6. AS WE MOVE FORWARD WITH BRAC 2005, IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT COMMANDS UNDERSTAND THE NEED FOR, AND POTENTIAL PITFALLS WITH LOCAL COMMUNITY INTERACTION THROUGHOUT THE BRAC PROCESS. DOD PERSONNEL MAY NOT PARTICIPATE, IN THEIR OFFICIAL CAPACITY, IN THE ACTIVITIES OF ANY ORGANIZATION THAT HAS AS ITS PURPOSE, EITHER DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, THE GOAL OF INSULATING DOD BASES FROM CLOSURE OR REALIGNMENT OR STEERING THE RELOCATION OF DOD ACTIVITIES INTO THEIR PARTICULAR COMMUNITY. THE NAVY WILL CONTINUE TO ENCOURAGE TWO-WAY COMMUNICATION WITH LOCAL INTEREST GROUPS AND RECEIVE THEIR INPUT, HOWEVER, IT IS IMPORTANT THAT THESE GROUPS UNDERSTAND THAT ANY DATA THEY PREPARE FOR NAVY CANNOT BE USED IN OUR PART OF THE BRAC PROCESS. ALL DOD FACILITIES WILL BE REVIEWED, AND ALL RECOMMENDATIONS WILL BE BASED ON APPROVED, PUBLISHED SELECTION CRITERIA AND A FUTURE FORCE STRUCTURE PLAN.

7. THIS GUIDANCE IS DIRECTED TO ENSURE THE FAIRNESS AND RIGOR OF THE

BRAC PROCESS. THE BRAC COMMISSION WILL SOLICIT COMMUNITY INPUT ONCE IT HAS RECEIVED THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE'S BRAC RECOMMENDATIONS IN MAY 2005. IDLE SPECULATION AS TO PROSPECTIVE CLOSURES AND REALIGNMENTS, EVEN WITHIN DOD, ONLY SERVES TO UNDERMINE BRAC PROCESS INTEGRITY. PUBLIC AFFAIRS GUIDANCE WILL BE ISSUED VIA SEPCOR.

8. IT IS ESSENTIAL WE RETAIN A FOCUS ON THE BRAC PROCESS AND ENSURE SECDEF'S GOAL TO "RATIONALIZE OUR INFRASTRUCTURE WITH DEFENSE STRATEGY" IS COMPLETED. WHILE RECOGNIZING THE REQUIREMENTS TO SUPPORT THE PROCESS WILL BE SIGNIFICANT, YOUR DILIGENCE IN ENSURING TIMELY, RESPONSIVE DATA IS ESSENTIAL TO THE SUCCESS OF THIS EFFORT.//
