Dear Former Rep Hansen:

I realize you will be receiving thousands of letters stating why Cannon AFB should remain in Clovis, NM, but I would like to let you know my view, for historical, military and sentimental reasons.

I am the office manager in an accounting firm; 75% of our clients are small businesses. If Cannon is closed the loss of jobs would be much higher than the estimated 20.5%. Our estimate is closer to 40%. The loss of revenue to our businesses would result in many Clovis area business failures.

My great-grandparents homesteaded on the land Cannon Air Force Base is located on and my Mother was born in their home which was across the street from the present Headquarters building. Most of the old larger trees were planted by my great-grandparents. For these reasons Cannon is special to our family.

My husband was stationed at Cannon Air Force Base when we met and married thirty-five years ago. After leaving the Air Force we continued to live in Clovis and he is now in Civil Service at CAFB. My husband does have enough years to retire, but he is very concerned about the men under him who do not have enough years.

I personally have known previous base commanders, several squadron commanders and many others who believe Clovis is a great place to live. They have chosen to retire or be discharged here because of the people, great weather and many other reasons. With the Melrose Bombing Range, you have good flying days, you are not land locked and the super sonic air space. Just some of the military reasons for keeping Cannon, but I am sure you have heard this many times before.

Charles Lindbergh liked our area so much that he established the airfield on the site of the present Cannon Air Force Base in 1929. Please study the data very carefully when making your decision, I know there are many factors to be studied, and you are aware that your decision will make a huge economic impact on our area. Thank you for taking the time to read my letter.
